Shown by Mike Barlow, Heartland Moonglow was the Junior Reserve World's Champion of Champions at Louisville and the Reserve UPHA Hackney Pony Classic Grand Champion at the American Royal. Look for her to be shown by owner Kay Marschel this year. Mike and Kathy Barlow of Buffalo Creek Farms are also the trainers of Razzle Dazzle Me (Dun-Haven Classic Edition X Heartland Double Treat) who was a Reserve World's and National Champion in Hackney Pleasure Driving with Kay on the lines.

Pictured above is the exciting gelding Talladega Red (Supreme Heir and out of Summer Starlet). Expertly trained and shown by Dena Lopez at her Double D Ranch in Versailles, Kentucky, he was the Junior Park Pleasure Champion at both Shelbyville and the All American Classic. He will likely be shown by both Dena and Kay in 2008. Dena also trains the glamorous Fine Harness gelding Supreme Spotlight (Supreme Heir X Special Spotlight) and Heartland Breaking News (Heartland Equality X Heartland Dainty Miss) who finished the 2007 season as the Hackney Pony Pleasure Driving Grand Champion at Shelbyville with Kay driving.
