Eighty-eight years and still going strong. It's the oldest horse show in the West. It's a wonderful experience during the fourth of July week! There's sun, sea, surf, fantastic weather, and wonderful things to see and do between classes. Santa Barbara is known as one of the West Coast's most popular tourist attractions; it's a wonderful place to take the whole family. A fantastic show management team, delightful show grounds, just a few blocks from the ocean, and it's chock-full of nostalgia.

At sundown you can almost see some of the renowned horsemen and women of the past who have shown their many famous champions here over the years. Coming around the corner, Cynthia Wood guiding Magic Marvel on her way to taking one more stake class. Bob Lewis in the buggy behind one of the greatest harness horses that ever lived, Monte Scott. The exquisite mare, that's as fine as a deer, Tender Mist with Carol Smith Shannon. How many of you knew that show manager Rae Deane Stone won all three of the stakes in 1968 before leaving California for 20 years to become one of the country's foremost trainers in Kentucky. Nostalgia — it's all here — 88 years of it

But go into the stands today and watch the incredible horses we have now. They're every bit as good as what we had then and what there is in the rest of the country. The West Coast shocks most judges who come out expecting to see academy horses in the stake classes. With mouths gaping open, they gasp at the quality, the talent and the enthusiasm that is the West Coast. Most of these stars never go to Kentucky to show. They don't see any reason to. We have some of the greatest horse shows in the country right here.

With four days of classes at 10:00 a.m., and 6:30 p.m., it's an easy schedule for exhibitors. For the 14th year, competition manager Rae Deane Stone and show secretary Harriet Landrum, saw to it that every detail was in place. Two arenas are going at one time: The main coliseum offered the Saddlebreds, judged by Mark Utoft of St. Charles, Illinois; the Friesian Regional Championships, judged by Richard Petty of Santa Barbara; the Walking Horses and Paso Finos. The adjacent arena showcased the Welsh show, with Cecile Dunn of Weirsdale, Florida judging a cast of thousands of ponies. It is a relaxing show and everyone seemed to be having a good time.

#### Five-Gaited

Always a very special treat, CCV Casey's Final Countdown with Michele Macfarlane, was in top form taking both the open and the open stake. This is the American Saddlebred at his very best. Electrifying!

Debra Valner is on a roll. After nailing the amateur stake at Charity Fair, she gathered up Callaway's Arbitrator and put on another horse show! This pair is exciting to watch. Both the amateur open and stake were theirs, with trainer Jen Dixon picking up the trophies for owner Patricia Martin.

The junior exhibitors are amazing. Talented Ali Bishop put in a most professional performance with her beautiful chestnut mare, Tip Me Do, winning the five-gaited juvenile stake. This little gal knows how to ride a horse! Trainer Bill Tomin is her guiding light.

Laura Denenholz has come a long way this year under Jim

Bennett's guidance. Her new five-year-old, Undulata's Confidential, is just the ticket. Paired with this darling chestnut gelding, Laura is making tracks into the winners' circles. The juvenile championship and the reserve grand championship belonged to them. Look for them at Louisville under Hoppy Bennett's banner.

The junior/limit class showcased a flashy chestnut with all the right moves. Guided by Roman Marcos, The Big Unit took the blue for owner Julie Greenbaum Belgrad.

Oh so cute! Jennifer Sandefur's precious baby, Busting Out, is the star of the West Coast shows this year. You just have to see him. Again, he took the victory pass in the five-gaited three-year-old class with David Blevins.

#### Three-Gaited

Victoria Lynn, the perennial beauty, has been undefeated on the West Coast for four years. Jim Cherry guided her to yet another pair of blues in the three-gaited open and stake for Zazen Ranch. She's remarkable and on her way to Louisville with Helen Cherry in the irons.

Jennifer Sandefur is riding on top of the world these days with her new stable, Crown Valley Farm. Trainer David Blevins has put everything in perfect order up there in Somis, Calif. Jennifer topped the three-gaited amateur and amateur stake with her sassy chestnut mare, Too Much Talk.

Is there a prettier picture than a beautiful young lady in top hat and formal attire guiding her graceful three-gaited mare to victories in the juvenile class and the juvenile stake? Julia Chen did just that with her CH Like Sunshine. Weber/Craghead trainer.

A delectable chestnut baby is making waves. Lady Avalon is Sally Nottage's pride and joy. She is by Avant and out of the mare that Sally won so many classes with in the past, The Babe. This lovely mare offered a beautiful performance to win the three-gaited junior/limit class with Don Deardorff. Another blue went to Dance By Design, with Matthew Roberts for Amy Dru, in the three-gaited three-year-old class.

#### Fine Harness

successfully defending his undefeated status, with Jim Cherry on the lines for Zazen Ranch. Sixteen blues in a little more than a year ... a fair day's work. The open and open stake belonged to them.

No Jacket Required, with owner Sally Spaulding, gracefully sailed through the amateur stake and they put the blue on his bridle. Weber/Craghead trainers. A Solar Flare made the transition from three-gaited to fine harness last year, and is proving it was the right move. The amateur fine harness class belonged to him, with owner Julie Greenbaum Belgrad on the lines. Roman and Cayce Marcos, trainers.

The babies are fantastic this year: A colorful mare, Fair Hill's Blondie, with Derek Repp for Linda and Mickey Brittan, took the honors in the three-year-old class.

Robb Wallen guided the wonderful bay gelding Winsdown Bridgeworks down the victory path in the two-year-old fine harness class for owners Bob and Paula Lovo.

#### **Park/Park Pleasure**

Peritime, with Kendall Weber for Helen Cherry, took the park open and stake with panache. A top performance from Theo Robinson, Liz Bolton's assistant trainer, brought the colorful stallion, Wee Pee's Meadows, owned by Linda Nicholas, to the top of the large junior/limit park class.

Don Deardorff guided Imagine The Dream to two blues in the park pleasure open and stake for Karen Lachman.

#### **Show Pleasure**

A name never fit a horse any better. Texas Gunslinger. Cocky, conceited, arrogant and little bit of swagger ... a chubby spotted horse that shot everyone down in his class. He hasn't shown but once, there at Santa Barbara last year, in eight years. Where has he been and why haven't we had the pleasure of watching this cute gelding? We hope he stays on the Circuit. He's adorable! He trounced 16 other good entries in the adult three-gaited show pleasure open and stake with Michele Macfarlane.

Shelby Jackson did a great job with her new chestnut gelding Explosive Material. Guided by David Hysaw, they conquered the juvenile three-gaited show pleasure stake and had a good reserve in the juvenile qualifying class. The lovely black mare Callaway's Party Time, posed for the victory shot in the juvenile show pleasure class and took reserve in the stake. Piloted by cute Sami Bishop and guided by bill Tomin, this team is precious.

Periapator's Chief Executive, with owner Carolyn Hohenberger, topped the stiff competition in the junior/limit horse three-gaited show pleasure class. Trained by Liz Bolton, the big bay was impressive.

What more can be said about her that hasn't already been said. She's the notorious lady, CH Sprinkles, an icon on the West Coast. She was the five-gaited show pleasure open and stake champion with Michele Macfarlane.

The show pleasure driving class was completely dominated by It's Good Karma with owner Julie Greenbaum

#### **Country Pleasure**

It was Michele Macfarlane in the spotlight again with the beautiful bay and white spotted mare Sunlight And Shadows, taking the three-gaited country pleasure open and stake.

Callaway's Spring Blossom was a standout winning the five-gaited country pleasure class and stake. Presented by Cheyenne Banks-Diaz for Debbie and Beau Rash and trained by Anne Speck.

A perennial winner in this division did it again. CV Prowler's Keepsake, with owner Amy Vicker-Smith guided the glitzy black gelding to wins in the country pleasure driving open and stake. Weber/Craghead trainers.

#### **Hunt Seat**

A personal best for Deborah Jones and her lovely mare, Thank Heaven. Absolutely perfect performances garnered two blues for the pair in the hunter country pleasure division. Deb trains Heaven herself and does a marvelous job. But it all couldn't be done without the help of her darling little son, Hunter.

#### **Western**

The current reigning world grand champion CH Fiasco, was on top of both the western country pleasure open and stake with Doug Glick for Carolyn Glick. Weber/Craghead trainer. Shari Rainwater guided Highpoint's Tip Top to the blue in the junior/limit western country pleasure class. Highpoint's Born To Boogie, with owner Michelle Ganci,

won the *Saddle & Bridle* Shatner Western pleasure class.

#### **Equitation**

Laura Denenholz was the star of the equitation division, winning the 14-17 class, the stake, and the NHS Good Hands class, under the direction of Jim Bennett. Clara Silvara was the 13 and under champion, with trainer Jen Dixon picking up the trophy. Cheyenne Banks-Diaz aced the pattern to win the UPHA Challenge Cup class. Anne Speck, trainer. And Kendall Weber was picture perfect taking the adult equitation class. Weber/Craghead trainer.

#### **10 and Under**

This is one of the cutest pictures we've seen in a long time. Kirwan Kennedy on her dark bay gelding CH Holy Fruit Salad. "Fruit" was, for many years, Mrs. Alan Robeson's fine harness star. Now he's Kirwan's star, taking incredible care of her in the most elegant way. She took three blues in the 10 and under, walk/trot division with elegance: the UPHA Challenge Cup, the equitation class and the pleasure class. This precious child is going to Louisville. She's adorable.

#### **Ponies/Roadsters**

Heartland King Of Kings, with owner Joanne Weiner, was the Hackney pony pleasure driving champion and grand champion. Tres Chic, with owner Kendall Weber, was the roadster pony open and stake winner. Weber/Craghead trainers. The classic road horse, Main Man, took victory passes in both the open and the stake with Fidencio Maturino on the lines for Bob Facciola.

#### **Friesians**

The IFSHA, International Friesian Region 10 Championships, were held at the Santa Barbara National for the second time this year. The class "A" division drew a wonderful representation of the breed. Ron and Janna Goldman's Friesians were stunning, as usual, taking a good number of

As always, the Santa Barbara National was a delightful, well run show. This is an event that should last another 88 years.
