Commander” for his last appearance “on the road” to mark these special events. The hospitality concluded with Saturday’s scrumptious breakfast buffet that was catered and sponsored by the Tanbark Cavalcade of Roses Horse Show board, which has been headed by Doug Lindstrom and Sally Snyder Tesch for three of the show’s 53 years.

New on this year’s agenda, in addition to nearly 300 horses and riders on display, were the six \$100 cash prizes awarded for every five horses entered. This money went to one of the many trainers who brought stock to the show. A free tack stall was offered to any trainer who hadn’t attended this show since 2004, an incentive for many new barns or returning barns to come back and “experience something

Minnesota.”

The popular “Horses for Sale” presentation was held following Thursday morning’s session, and the real bonus was that there was, in addition to the Tanbark show program featuring artwork by Heather Tatarek, a sale catalog where you could advertise your horse for sale and then present it on Thursday if you so chose. Many thanks to returning Minnesota trainer Pat Wessel and the Rademanns for amply providing many of the horses for sale that were displayed.

Tanbark 2007 was again a benefit show for We Can Ride, Inc., which offers therapeutic horseback riding and carriage driving to adults and children living with disabilities. Founded in 1982, We Can Ride, Inc., has four locations in

Tanbark management also took a hint from the people at the Madison Classic Horse Show, which is UPHA Chapter 3/4’s Chapter horse show (these chapters serve Wisconsin, Iowa, Minnesota and the Dakotas) and they handed out an informational bulletin to all exhibitors. They also gave each barn a rose plant for attending the show.

Once again, a highly successful silent auction went on all week until its close on Friday. Many thanks to Donna Beck, Dee Fredericks and Claudia Peltier for all their work on this year’s silent auction.

Great weather moved in on Wednesday, just in time for the start of the show, after a sweltering Monday and Tuesday with temperatures in the upper 90’s. The horses, the grooms, the trainers and just about anyone else in the vicinity, appreciated the climate change.

And now ... *on with the show.*

Five-Gaited

No show in Minnesota would be complete without the Hammerlund clan’s attendance. Their presence always adds flavor to any show. Patriarch Bill, whose undying profession of faith in anything that one of his kids or grandkids shows, is to be admired, and matriarch Lynn, who has a way of keeping everyone in line, while supporting them all at the same time, is also to be admired. Anne Hammerlund was the ladies five-gaited victor with the Mean Machine son, Showcase’s Dream Machine, and her brother, Matt, was the open winner with family favorite, Magic Remembrance.

Blair Cox Townsend, who was reserve in the ladies class, returned for victory in the ladies five-gaited stake with the ground-covering Callaway’s Northern Exposure, under the direction of Renata Engel.

Lindsay Kellner had a great week in Minnesota, and her music lovin’ dad was burnin’ up the cell phone minutes calling mom, Holly Van Hecke, who was helping make the world a more sighted place, to report Lindsay’s wins with their newly acquired Unspoken Intentions, by Trust Fund.

Catalyst’s Work Of Art, who had won one of the best classes of the week at the recent Midwest Charity Horse show with Andy Freseth up for Nancy Leigh Fisher in the junior five-gaited division, were again on hand at Tanbark for victory in the junior event. Andy is preparing this mare for two outings at the World’s Championship Horse Show.

Novice honors were handily taken by

Lindsey Ward aboard Cerise Kogl-O'Neil's sporty new entry, Callaway's Braveheart, by Callaway's The Gipper, whom she acquired from Tom Scott prior to his move to Missouri.

The late "Reggie" (aka Roseridge Heir), was lookin' down on his get, Keep Me Posted, a 2006 World's Champion with Neva Van Ess in the junior gaited division, and CH Roseridge's Gold and Doug Lindstrom, many-time champions in the amateur ranks with only the proudest of expressions. Keep Me Posted returned in the gaited stake on Saturday night to close Tanbark 2007 with the tricolor nod for owner Nick Neviaser. Neviaser also had the winning ride in a very competitive five-gaited pleasure 28 and under class with the unbelievably versatile CH Harlem's Hot Ticket, and also a unanimous win with the colorful and enchanting Star Material son, The Mystery Machine, in the juvenile show pleasure stake, for what was, probably, if not definitely, Nick's best ride on "Scooby" to date.

Parker (aka Roseridge's Gold), and his partner Doug Lindstrom, a longtime prodigy of Cary Bartz's Valiant Stables, took top honors in the amateur five-gaited qualifier and stake. Doug's expertise getting a horse around a ring really shined through. Reserve honors went to another crowd favorite, as the much-improved combination of Mike Elnicky and CF Night's First Impression, by CF First Night Out and out of the dam of past winner Ms. Rita Hayworth, rose to the occasion on Friday night. The

Elnickys have been staunch supporters of the activities of the Saddlebred in Minnesota for more than a decade.

Three-Gaited

Lynda Freseth finished off nicely what her customer Ericka Gaiswinkler Nelson started with the highly athletic mare Sue She, by Periaptor, in the ladies three-gaited division, with qualifier honors being taken by Ericka and Lynda returning for the championship go after Ericka had to leave to go on a family cruise with the entire Gaiswinkler brood.

Sue She's chestnut paternal blood sister, RWC Sunshine Way, took reserve honors in two exquisite performances in the ladies division for new owner Toni Guarnera, and now under the direction of Bob Jensen Stables.

Emily Scharpf is one young lady who is having a great year. Not only did she adapt to an equitation rider in the 11th hour aboard CH Louisville Lass on loan to the Scharpfs from the Krentz family, but she has also shown versatility as a rider with her new gaited horse Callaway's Where There's A Will. But the year she's had with, what probably is the most suitable horse Emily will ever have, the gifted gelding SA Nelmar's Tango 4 Ever, borders on unbelievable. Tango has yet to meet with defeat (1-2-3-4-5-6-7-8-9-10, said quickly to avoid jinxing you!) In 2007 with performances of animation and talent at Des Moines, Madison, Midwest and now Tanbark, they undeniably took both juvenile classes. Reserve honors went to the pony, the little engine who not only could but did, Tip O' The Hat and Brittany Balagna.

Terri Anne Ullman had two really nice three-gaited geldings in tow with her Winsome Farm Saddlebreds group. The exciting, talented and, at times, snaky three-year-old Catalyst son, Cataclysmic, really is showing signs of being a great one. That makes it two classes shown and two wins after his earlier score at Madison Classic. He is owned and was bred by Dr. Laura Sukowaty, "Leo" was the UPHA Classic Champion with Terri Anne in the irons. Open honors went to the gorgeous bay Gypsies Tramps & Thieves for new owner Carrie Glapinski. This handsome boy is sired by Gypsy Santana and his maternal granddam is the dam of the five-gaited celebrity, CH Jaunty Jeanette.

Kate Baumann is one lady who really enjoys showing her good-natured big gelding Up Close & Personal WRF. This Merchant Prince (I know, I know, he doesn't look like your typical Merchant Prince Horse) son is atop the ribbons most everywhere he goes. Known around the barn as "Percy," you'd be hard pressed to erase the smile off Kate's face after

she gets off him. They were the amateur three-gaited grand champions after a nice reserve behind the snorty, many times champion To Die For with the gutsy and very lovely young Meredith Steinhauer in the irons for the open stake after the amateur qualifier win. To Die For is a son of Fox Creek and if you like him it's probably because you favor the Grape Tree's Fox breeding!

Fine Harness

The fine harness division was the lightest of all the show performance divisions. Taking the novice, the open and the stake, was the coppery chestnut mare Gretchen's Gift as shown by Rick Wallen on behalf of Ann MacMurray Cox from Canada. This mare is by Phi Slama Jama and out of a daughter of WC Party Train. Reserve in both the open and novice class was Attache's Rainmaker, the Madison Classic fine harness champion, shown by Cary Bartz on behalf of ZFE Saddlebreds.

Executive Heir, by Con Heir and out of the good producing mare Rubyanna, was the two-year-old champion for owners and breeders Jay and Jean Wood of Plato, Minn. The Woods are having success with their small breeding program, with many nice youngsters being produced through their efforts.

Park

This ever-growing division was well-represented in not only quality, but also in numbers. On Friday evening, Cary Bartz stepped up in a big field of junior park pleasure horses with Chryse and Vaughn Veit's very pretty liver chestnut mare Crystal Kisses to win that event, unanimously. Crystal Kisses is out of Chryse's 1992 Minnesota Limited Breeders' Futurity champion, for whom she had a trophy designed, and which is given out at the Minnesota Futurity each fall.

Jenny Carlsen, another lifelong Minnesota rider, and a talented one at that, even if she did babysit for my friend and business competitor Allison Bailey as a kid (all kidding aside), rode the cute bay Winnepeg Parks, who was raised by Jenny's good friend and Minnesota breeder, Penny Eckert, to the amateur park pleasure championship under the direction of Rob and Stephanie Kritzler's Greenwood Stables. The Kritzlers also received the nod in the juvenile country pleasure stake with Afton Greif and Callaway's Simon Says. "Simon says, go to the winner's circle and collect your tricolor." Remember, you only go if the person says Simon says first ... and they did!

Terri Anne Ullman had the nod in the novice/junior park class with Cindy and Tom Price's newly acquired Mystic Pointe. Cindy is one pool-shootin' kinda gal and Tom is Mr.

Olympiad Universe, and it's no wonder that the combination, along with Terri Anne's expertise, would produce a winner in the ring.

Lynda and Andy Freseth each presented nice young park horses for clientele at Tanbark 2007. Andy had Guy and Karen Smith's sporty, watch-eyed Brookhill's King Of Kool, by CH Harlem Town, marching his big trot and looking much more mature in 2007 for the park pleasure open and stake classes. Lynda, on the other hand, had a demanding customer (just kidding) in her son and daughter-in-law, Jeffrey and Kelly Williamson, and their friend, Bonnie Kegley, when she debuted their newly acquired Got No Shame, by Desert's Supreme Memories, in the UPHA Park Pleasure Classic event. Got No Shame was a 2006 WC with Debbie Foley at the lines in the fine harness division and under the ownership of Thomas Caisses of Kohler Morgan Stables fame.

The dapple grey gelding Day's Grecian Grey basically repeated his wins in Madison where he won the open park class with Scott Matton presenting before turning the young gelding over to good riding owner Michelle Krentz for her wins in the amateur and amateur park stake classes. "Preston" was then eligible for "CH" status upon the accomplishment of said tricolor. He is by Sultan's Great Day.

The Border Star is always a contender in any ring and has been no matter if in harness

or under saddle. There is nothing fuzzy about the line drawn in the sand where this athletic mare is concerned. Owned by Mike and Jane Schallock's Star Hill Farm, she was shown for them to the open park horse win by Rick Wallen. The Schallocks also had the winning bid in the amateur roadster pony stake when Mike came, saw and conquered that event defeating the wonderful Calvin Hobbs, who had earlier won the qualifier with top equitator Kevin Ingram at the lines for the James Dellinger family's Delton Farm. Hollow Haven Farm took home all top pony honors with the leggy and top quality Pacifico's Standing Ovation and Bob Anderson in the pleasure domain and the also leggy and ground covering Heartland Sundust and Mary Gise having been reunited in 2007 since Gise's sale of Calvin Hobbs to the Dellingers for Mary and "Sunny's" open and open stake championship tricolor. Of course, mom, Priscilla, cheered on this duo from the sidelines.

Show, Country, and Open Pleasure

The open pleasure division is a popular commodity at Iowa and Minnesota shows (I know, I know, you've often read that if you've been a loyal subscriber throughout my employment with *Saddle & Bridle*, which is going on 16 years now ... good God, I had to lay down after typing that!) and the numbers in these classes is as impressive as often is the quality.

Making a huge impression on the judges at this show was the three-time World's Champion pleasure horse, CH Shiny New Penny, who was shown for the first time by his trainer to all those WC titles, Neva Van Ess, and under the ownership of Marilyn Haugen. "Penny," as he is affectionately known, really rose to the occasion as Neva used the experience to school him for Haugen's young daughter, Natalie. Natalie won the 11-17 and juvenile open pleasure stakes, and Neva won the 18-38 and adult open English pleasure stakes. Four for four! CH Shiny New Penny is by Sultan's Starmaker and out of a daughter of the one-time harness mare, Diamond Minx. Winter Pearl, owned by Dr. Luanne Wendland, and shown by Bob Jorgensen, was the reserve grand champion. This mare had a winning record in 2006 with Todd Hovland presenting on Wendland's behalf in the junior pleasure division.

Winstead Kirkpatrick presented Grace Meyer's very nice black hunter pleasure gelding to the open hunter pleasure win. Winstead is a member, though not for long due to his decision to further his education, of the training team at Centre Pointe Stables.

The personality-plus Cameron Gallenberg and her much loved Angelina Ballerina were

the 10 and under open English winners. If you want to know anything about this mare, including her many barn names, just stop Cameron and ask her. If you can't find her, just look for Lindsey Ward's mom, Cheryl. Mom Kim had a winning week with her western pleasure geldings Smith & Wesson, who took the junior/novice over Next Day Heir and Brendan Heintz for new owners Michelle Winer and Lori Parks, and Braveheart Of Silver Oaks, who was the open country western champion and reserve grand champion behind the 22-year-old "youngster" and perennial winner, CH Impressive Ruler, who took the stake after winning the Orchard Height's Ramblin' Rose Memorial Perpetual Trophy offered by former exhibitor and top hairstylist, Sue Montgomery. Braveheart Of Silver Oaks also took the open western bridlepath class. *Saddle & Bridle* Working Western and Shatner Western Pleasure victories were both scored by the delightful combination of Char Sondrall and Winsdown Diamond Dee, who were enthusiastically cheered on by Kay Halvorson and many of the rest of us in the stands. It is such a pleasure to see someone like Char having such a great time with her fun horse.

Brianna Meyer and CH Hometown Commander were the open English pleasure 17 and under rider champs for the Dellinger family after a win in the 13 and under country pleasure over Natalie Haugen and Storm's A Brewing. Kathy Rhoades' new entry Walterway's High Enough, has such quality he'd get noticed anywhere in the land as he did in the novice rider adult 18 and over and novice rider championship events under the direction of Heartland Stables' mother and daughter training team of Simpson & Vogel.

This same barn produced the winner of Erica Mundt and Caraman who were the *Saddle & Bridle* Hunter Seat Classic and hunter on the flat champions, much to the delight of William Woods University recruiters on hand.

Hollow Haven Farm had big wins in the adult show pleasure 18-38 and the adult championship events with the recent Midwest and Bonnie Blue champion CH Ninety Eight Degrees and Susan Brock Creekmore. Reserve in the qualifier went to the consistent CH My Grande and Amanda Dellinger. Reserve stake honors went to the Des Moines and FASH champions Kristen Olson and the recent CH Knock Knock Who's Their. Speaking of Rocky "Knock Knock", you gotta love a show horse who has the mindset of going in the leadline class too as he did with Summer Olson, granddaughter of Tom and Sherie Nelson. It is nice to see this family back "in action" again after much success in Kristen's single days with the great CH Preferred Prince.

CH Callaway's Pretty Penny and the inimitable style of former gym teacher Nancy Brown Anderson are a hard act to beat. That feat has only been done one time in their five, almost six, full seasons of competition together. Tanbark was not the place of any such happening. Reserve honors in this competitive qualifier of 11 and championship of 9 went to the also personality-plus Barbara Hendrickson celebrating her 35th anniversary at the show to husband Stephen, a car lover, with her top quality Pierre Cardin, by Designed.

Same results in the show pleasure driving for Elizabeth James Lipscomb, who is enjoying

a fairytale season with her sporty CH Shot With Glory, by Reedann's Top Gun and out of Glori-Phi, after repeating her Midwest Charity wins from 10 days earlier. Epiphany and Doug Fiola, as polite a man as you'll ever meet, and Epiphany, a lovely Roseridge Heir daughter, were reserve to Shot With Glory under the direction of Jared Ratzloff in the qualifier, whereas Juvenile champions Lyndi Skinner and WC Showboat's Casino were the reserve grand champions under the direction of Jonnie Surland. Jared also now takes responsibility for Kandi Rust's pretty bay Lovin' It who took top honors in the country pleasure novice horse event.

Hollow Haven Farm seemingly dominated in the amateur pleasure classes with wins posted, literally posted, by CH The Shadow Knows and Linda Meyer in the 39 and over country pleasure and the adult country pleasure championships. This duo won the 2006 World's Championship title, and Nosy won at Louisville in 2004, 2005, and 2006 in this division with three different riders. He is one of Andy Freseth's all-time favorite horses.

Country pleasure 18-29 honors went to Meredith Steinhauer and Colin Powell. Other pleasure qualifier wins were taken by Jenna Winquist and CH I'm Radiant Too in the show pleasure 13 and under division, as well as the reserve grand championship in the juvenile show pleasure stake. Turn Up The Heir and Gretchen Bentz were victorious in the 14-17 show pleasure, and Jenna's mom, Sally, and her BIG gelding Because I Said So, roared into the show pleasure 39-48 class like a tiger in a china shop and also took the novice show pleasure horse class under the direction of Terri Anne Ullman.

Jensen Stables' Dorian Stulberg Anderson and Reedann's Phorget-Me-Not continued their winning streak in the junior pleasure classes as they did with earlier wins at FASH, Madison and Des Moines.

Nancy Seward and The Swan Princess marched a big trot in the 49 and over show pleasure for the nod, and Addie Miller and Raindrops And Roses took a blue back to Centre Pointe Stables in the novice gaited pleasure.

MMMBop returned, after an earlier reserve to Harlem's Hot Ticket in the 28 and under gaited pleasure, and made a bold impression on the judges for the Grand National added money win with owner/rider Amanda Dellinger in the stake. Cool Down Papa and Rachel Pricer caused commotion in the stands with the enthusiastic response of the good people at Westwood Farm for reserve. Quidditch and Janet Thompson earned a nice berth for a

good ribbon in the championship after a big win in the 29 and over class under the direction of Renae Van Zomeren. Especially nice for Janet is that this gelding, whose barn name is "Ozzie," was raised by Janet and her mom, Marjorie.

Equitation

What's better than being the parent of a winning rider? I think, based on observation, that the answer to this question would be to be the grandparent of one. And when your grandparent is also a horse trainer, well, that makes the victory all the more sweet. That is the case for young Taylor Williamson, whose father Dean is the son of Jensen Stables' Linda Jensen. Linda married Bob when Dean and his brothers were very young and the whole family now enjoys the horse shows. Taylor, combined with the proven Baron's Dreams & Schemes were the Walk & Trot UPHA Challenge Cup champions and the walk & trot only reserve grand champions behind Kaitlyn Creekmore and Imagination Station who ride under the direction of Lynda Freseth. Lynda is the "instructive" grandparent to Kaitlyn in that she instructed Kaitlyn's mom, Susan Brock, as a young girl when Lynda was a wee bit of a thing back in her homestate of Virginia.

Bob and Linda Jensen and their talented staff of young horsewomen were also proud of the efforts turned in by the gorgeous combination of Emily Collins and Ro & Me's Chanti's Prayer, by Trust Fund. This lovely mare, whose quality is obvious even to the non-horseperson, and Emily are really starting

to blossom together. They showed twice in one day and won both the NHS Good Hands Event and the equitation 17 and under events much to the delight of the trio of judges.

Anna has the length of leg, not to mention she's a gorgeous girl, that the judges found appealing for the win in the UPHA Pleasure Challenge Cup, the 14-17 pleasure equitation and the pleasure equitation championship classes, sweeping her divisions.

Rachel performed beautifully aboard the handsome bay Titleist Symbol for the equitation championship title under the direction of Hollow Haven Farm.
