A horse show held in conjunction with a State Fair takes on a different look and feel. The 2007 North Carolina State Fair Horse Show was the same as it has been for the many years I have been there — full of non-stop action — “fair food” — and non-horse people in the stands, i.e., a crowd to show your horse in front of. There is a full schedule of classes starting early in the morning and running through late evening. The large diversity of breeds of horses you see keeps things interesting. Classes for Saddlebreds, Hackneys, Road Horses and Road Ponies, along with the Southeastern Hackney Futurity babies, began Wednesday night, October 17, and ran through Saturday night Oct. 20, with start times as early as 5:30 p.m. The early start time is new, and planned around a four hour session that ends prior to the nearby nightly fireworks display, set for 9:45 p.m. Folks find those fireworks thrilling and beautiful to watch, while some horses simply don't.

For the second year in a row this long running late season show hosted the ASHA Region Nine Atlantic Coast Regional Championship classes, with a full roster of 23. Those winning the beautiful ribbons seemed thrilled. For after-the-show entertainment there was Friday evening's Southeastern Hackney Association Social, a well attended get together held just outside the show arena. Five-Gaited Division

Big and bold when he racks and trots, and looking good with his

striking gray color, would be a fitting description of the Five-Gaited Grand Champion and Limit Five-Gaited champion from N.C. State Fair. Lewis Eckard trains and rode this standout for what I would have to say is one of “the” most excited owners, Becky Brown Rankin. New to the Carolina circuit was the high-headed Reserve Grand Champion, Red Hot and Bothered. Matt Shiflet trains him for Gabriella Flynn. The exciting team of Ima Starbuck and good riding Julie

Burmeister proved hard to beat, winning both the Open and Ladies Five-Gaited classes under the training of Paul Boone. Red Hot and Bothered and Matt were reserve in the Open Five-Gaited class, while the talented Ventura's Gold Card and Sara Scheck were reserve in the Ladies class. I'm Fantabulous and Matt Shiflet for Beth Ann Rhoads trotted out with the red ribbon from the Limit Five-Gaited class. Wasabi and Lewis Eckard were in blue ribbon form for the title of Novice Five-Gaited champions, ahead of the highly applauded team of Iconium and Steve Allred. The athletic Anadon's Ruth and Matt Shiflet, for Monty and Carl Hess, were in blue ribbon form for the Junior Five-Gaited victory pass with Tornado Man and Suzy Shiflet taking home the red ribbon for Linesshare Farm.

Good numbers of entries made up the Amateur Five-Gaited classes in Raleigh. Making a move up through the ribbons from the qualifier to Amateur Five-Gaited Grand Champion was the promising team of Startalyst, Ann Cannon making husband, Bill, very proud. The striking team of Oscar Dela Hoya and Stacey Halloran moved up a notch from the Amateur Five-Gaited class to finish as Reserve Grand Champions. Catching the judge's eye and making the victory pass in the Amateur Five-Gaited class Wednesday night was the up-and-coming team of

Apollo Gold, Ginger Roseman teaming her young horse for the first time. Not A Moment Too Soon and Melanie Carroll took the red ribbon home to Virginia from the Amateur qualifier. Leatherwood's Hats Off and Ali Deutsch make quite the team in the Junior Exhibitor Five-Gaited classes. Their hard work paid off with not one but two victory passes at their season ending show. Got The Ticket and

Megan Barrett marched smartly up through the ribbons from their first class to proudly take home reserve Championship honors. The well-matched team of The Apprentice and Bree Zandy were called out for the red ribbon from the qualifier. In what turned out to be their final rides together, Small Packages and good riding Camille Cowart were perfectly in tune to win both the Five-Gaited Pony classes. The Jazzy Commander and Jackie Frame trotted out with the red ribbon both times out.

Three-Gaited Division

The Three-Gaited Championship on Saturday night was all about the many times champion Sublime Light. Jacqueline Leon had this big doing horse marching for the title for proud owners, Mr. and Mrs. Larry Young. This win followed their triumph in the Ladies Three-Gaited class where Designed A Prince Of Dreams and Marlene Thornton were reserve. The Open Three-Gaited class of one meant the blue ribbon for the promising young Champagne's China Doll, trainer Peter Cowart showing for Little Cahaba Properties. Making their debut under the West Wind Stables banner was the blue ribbon team of Soulmate and Barbara Barrett. They were steady up for the titles of Amateur Three-Gaited Champion and Grand Champion, with reserve both times out all for the consistent Periaptor's Dancing Star and Dr. Teresa Miller. The Junior/Novice Three-Gaited standout was the photogenic Bubble Bath, Jamie Mullins in the irons for Jordan Banner Saddlebreds, with the red ribbon going home with Designed A Prince Of Dreams and Marlene Thornton.

The Junior Exhibitor Three-Gaited classes highlighted the talented combination of First Shot and Jordan Banner as they marched out with both titles. Designed A Prince Of Dreams and Ashley Neal rode up for the reserve honors both classes. Attache Allure and catch rider Meghan Toms had the entire ring to perform in. This talented youngster won both the Three-Gaited Pony classes and is primed and ready for young Anna Grace Whitworth in 2008.

Fine Harness Division

Elegant is a very appropriate part of the name for the Fine Harness Open and Grand Championship winner at the N.C. State Fair. Elegant Dreamcatcher put on quite the show in both of the good classes to wear the titles, and she is only a three-year-old.

Matt Shiflet is the trainer and Claude and Alice Shiflet are the excited owners. The proud looking, So Unique, had Krista Dent showing for Dr. Brian Garrett. They finished as Reserve Grand Champions. The leg-waving Lady O Lydia was teamed by Sam Allred for Steve Allred taking the red ribbon from the open class to Steve Allred Stables' tack room.

Saddle Seat Equitation Division

Saddle Seat Equitation riders for the older age groups simply weren't there. The Pleasure Equitation class for riders 17 and under saw only young Elizabeth Wall displaying her skills. The Saddle Seat Equitation classes for the riders 10 and under were dual wins for many times champion Cagle James, riding under the instruction of Lewis Eckard. Young Vanessa Patch was called out in reserve both classes.

Three-Gaited Park Division

As is the case at all of the shows I attend, the classes for the park horses are full of good ones; N.C. State Fair was certainly no exception. The dynamic and up-headed Shamrock's Asagi caught the judge's eye in both the Open Three-Gaited Park classes with winning results. Matt Shiflet is the trainer/rider and Jennie Graham and Vickie Keatley the proud owners. Moving up one notch from the Open Park class to finish as Reserve Grand Champions was a new face in the area, Cybertown, shown by Boone's Farm

and Stables' new assistant, Cydney Rae Cutchall. Many times champion First Asset had trainer Lewis Eckard up for All-Well Farm to finish reserve in the open class. A very large class of Junior Three-Gaited Park horses entered for their class on Wednesday night. Riding to the top of this talented group was Juliette's Deja Blue, shown by Matt Shiflet for Athanasuleas/Bowdre, just ahead of Princely Charm and Steve

Joyce for JK Investments LLC. The Amateurs and their exciting group of Three-Gaited Park horses featured many times champion CH Woulda Coulda Shoulda and Aimee Austin doing it again. CH Callaway's B Gratz Brown and Karin Banks had a terrific season ending ride to wear the title of reserve grand champions. Our Silver Charm and George Anne Nash took the red ribbon from the Amateur class back to Cameo Stable. Two good riding Junior Exhibitors traded top honors in their two classes at the N.C. State Fair. Here's Beanski and Lindsey Gettig made trainer Suzy Shiflet proud with their win of the Championship, as did The Color Of Night and Jesse Lynch for Margaret Gardiner in the qualifier.

The Park Pleasure classes are always enjoyable. The Park Pleasure Championship was another title in a long list for Showboat's Casablanca and Steve Joyce, riding for proud owner Marian Hunt Bramlett. Marian was in the saddle for the Open Park Pleasure class, finishing as reserve champion. CF Not Tonight Chief had Ginger Reagan catch riding for Lisa Austin for the reserve Park Pleasure Championship title. Unpretentious had trainer Christy Absher Johnson in the irons for Lynne Hege to make the victory pass as the Open Park Pleasure champions. The Three-Year-Old Park Pleasure class of three featured the newly purchased and classic looking Hi On Heir in the winner's circle. Bill Shiflet is the new trainer for his dad/new owner, Riley Shiflet. A Superior Night and Betsy Boone took reserve honors back to Boone's Farm and Stables.

Harness and Hackney Pony Division

The Harness Pony Championship tri-color went home to Bent Tree Farm with Night Editor and trainer Lee Hudson, as did the Open Harness Pony blue ribbon. Bent Tree Farm owner Karen Waldron was driving her beloved Vindicator as the solo entry in the Amateur Harness pony class. Reserve in both the Open and Championship were for Psycho and Jack Richards.

The Hackney Pony Championship was a winning debut for a new pony in the area. Heartland Invincible and trainer Heather Boodey won it all for new owner Paul Otto, following their blue ribbon go in the Southeastern Hackney Futurity Three-Year-Old 14.2 and Under class. Open Hackney Pony Champion Autumn Wood's Pick Me First, had Earnest Lambdin on the lines for Beth Jones. They were reserve back

in the Hackney Pony Championship. The Hackney/Harness Pleasure Driving Pony Championship and qualifier added to the already long winning list for the highly competitive Cover Story, driven by Brenda Rappaport for Wireless Valley Farm. Quorum's E.F. and Jeanette Jones took home the red ribbon from the qualifier. Regal's Class Act LF and Bland Craig took the red tri-color from the Championship back to Gary Altizer Stables. The Open Pleasure Driving Pony blue and tri-color were eye-catching turns of the track for Heartland's Bandelero and Wendy Myers, as they finished ahead of FCL Just A Miracle and Rebecca Jones. Rounding out the division was the AHHS Youth Medallion Hackney Pleasure Driving Pony with a solo performance by Rhett and Anna Hudson showing for Bent Tree Farm.

Southeastern Hackney Futurity

Ponies owned and exhibited by M.L. Gray proved hard to beat in the Southeastern Hackney Futurity classes offered at the N.C. State Fair Horse Show. First in the Three-Year-Old 12.2 and under class was M.L.'s GS Little Man, first in the Yearling Stallion/Gelding class was M.L.'s GS High Beam, and first in the Yearling Fillies class was M.L.'s GS Kit Kat. Second in the Two-Year-Old Stallion/Gelding class was M.L.'s GS Whiz, and second in the Weanling Stallions and Gelding class was M.L.'s GS Rock Star. The Futurity class for three-year-old Road Ponies and 12.2 and under was all for Jack Richard's Wonder Man. The two-year-old Stallion/Gelding blue was for RDA's Pope Benedict XVI and Carolyn Whitfield. The Weanling Stallions and Geldings blue went to STS Outer Limits, owned and shown by Earnest Lambdin.

Roadster Horse Division

WC Royal Count, very capably driven by Rebekah Cloninger, proved hard to beat in both the Amateur and Roadster To Bike Championship, much to the delight of the crowd. Wildwood Flower and Larry Scott made the Open Roadster To Bike victory pass and were a good reserve back in the Championship. Sue's Bad Moon and Steve Joyce picked up the red ribbon in the Open Class. Charlie Rob and owner/driver Steve Edwards did likewise in the Amateur class. Four speedy combinations made you take notice in the Road Horse Under Saddle classes. Many times champion Vivacious and Dr. Holly Ackerman sped to the win in the first class, ahead

Road Pony Division

Quickly getting a reputation as a highly competitive road pony is the game young Stat. This promising pony made his first venture into the show ring with Danny Troutman in April. Six months later his amateur owner, Dr. Robert (Chip) Pugh, is driving for the tri-color in the Open Championship at the North Carolina State Fair. When the judge's card was turned in, Stat and Chip had their tri-color, and a wealth of memories of their first season together. Stat and Chip won it all on Wednesday night as well, this from the Limit Road Pony class where Aragorn and Lee Hudson, for Bent Tree Farm, were reserve. The proud looking Hawkeye's Chatter Box had trainer Lewis Eckard in the bike for All-Well Farm to finish the season as Open Road Pony Champion and Reserve Grand Champion. Stat and Chip were reserve to Hawkeye's Chatter Box in the open class. The best-known and most titled amateur road pony on the Carolinas circuit would have to be Cappuccino. He and proud owner Brenda Kelly did it again winning both

the Amateur qualifier and Amateur Championship. The new team of WC Razz Ma Tazz and Dr. Chip Pugh took reserve honors from both Amateur classes back to Meadow Wood Stables. The UPHA Road Pony Classic had three new youngsters vying for the blue. Radiant's Triumph and owner/driver Tom Kirby were called out for the victory pass, just ahead of Bound For Jubilee and Lewis Eckard showing for Gina Lail.

Creating excitement in the Junior Exhibitor Road Pony Championship was the crowd-pleasing team of Seamair's Nobility and young Tanner Parham. They won it all on Saturday night, much to the delight of their many fans, and Tanner's huge family. Doing Time and Dustin Lassett, driving for Steve Edwards, drove away with reserve championship honors after making their own victory pass in the AHHS Youth Medallion Road Pony class. The always exciting Road Pony Under Saddle classes were yet another in a long list of wins for Bagheira and good riding Caitlin Leith showing for Bent Tree Farm. John Glenn and Courtney Babber had a good go as well, picking up reserve ribbons from both classes.

Show Pleasure Division

Classes for pleasure horses were many and varied at the N.C. State Fair Horse Show. The adult three-gaited show pleasure classes were very well filled with good quality horses. A fancy looking new face proved the one to beat in both classes. Auld Lang Syne was very handily shown by Luanne Kilday under the ownership of one very excited Mary Jane Lewis. Sometimes Gold and Jill White moved smartly up through the ribbons from the qualifying class to finish as reserve adult three-gaited pleasure grand champions. Miraculous Odds and Lauren Camp DeHaan took the red ribbon from the adult pleasure class back to Boone's Farm and Stables. The three-gaited show pleasure horses and their riders aged 14-17 had a repeat winner in the fancy CH Harlem's Moon Shadow. This veteran of the show ring was shown by good riding Jesse Lynch as she finished her Junior Exhibitor show career under the guidance of her teacher and friend, Margaret Gardiner. Mountainview's King For A Day and proud owner/rider Sharon Scott took red ribbons from both classes back to Meadow Wood Stables' tack room. The three-gaited show pleasure horses and their riders

13 and under showing in their championship class, heard loud cheers for the team of CH Future Treasure and Chandler Gray as they topped a good class. This veteran of the show ring and his young rider picked up their first blue ribbon in the Novice Rider class where Hot New Release and Fran Williford were a good reserve. The novice rider championship was a winning turn of the track for It's The Rage and Meghan Crider, reserve again for Hot New Release and Fran Williford. The perfectly matched team of The Chesapeake Bay and Austin Hazelwood were called out as reserve grand champions in the riders 13 and under class on this Saturday night. The new team of the perfectly mannered One Moore Harlem and Alli Smith caught the judge's eye for the victory pass from the riders 13 and under qualifier, where reserve was for Here's To The Night and Natalie Wilson. Going solo in the Amateur Owned and Trained class was More Moon Drops and Kimberly Oyler.

Seattle Song and Cagle James returned to the show ring to win it all from both the Walk and Trot Pleasure classes for riders 12 and under. Rock The Night and Allison Womack picked up the red ribbon from both of the classes of three. When you mention winning new teams in the Show Pleasure Driving classes, don't forget the big doing Selvaggio and proud new owner/driver Bonnie Koch. They ended their first season together as the Show Pleasure Driving Grand Champions and Champions. Finishing a close second both classes was the pert Stevie Nicks, Pat Yeatts in the buggy for Cherry Stone Farm LLC.

The Five-Gaited Show Pleasure classes were crowd pleasers as well. The four entries in both of the Adult classes were very competitive ones. Making their statement for the tri-color was the ageless CH Callaway's No Problem, shown by his proud owner Jean Myers. This followed their reserve in the adult qualifier. CH Social Worth and Aimee Austin turned back the competition in the adult qualifier, under the training of Mary Ann Harris. Reserve adult championship honors were all for the solid performer, Pepper Man, Courtney Maness in the irons. Making waves in the Junior Exhibitor Five-Gaited show pleasure classes is the new team of CH MMBop and talented Allie Wellington. They do seem to enjoy themselves in the ring. They won two more titles at the N.C. State Fair on

Country Pleasure Division

The perfect gentleman, Santana's Montana had his adoring rider/owner Dr. Holly Ackerman aboard for reserve honors in both of these quality classes. Named the best among the good quality Junior Exhibitor Country Pleasure horses for riders 14-17, was the stellar performer, CH Wing's Main Attraction, teamed by good riding Adrienne Fitch to both titles. Finn MacCumhail and Megan Williams moved smartly up through the ribbons from the qualifier to be named reserve grand champions. Matchplay and Bredin Rush took the red ribbon back to Heads Up! Academy's stalls following the qualifying class. The stylish looking Curly Day had good catch rider Anna Hudson in the irons for Lesley Cox to top both of the Junior Exhibitor Country Pleasure, riders 13 and under, classes. The new team of Spock and Natalie Watkins took home reserve championship honors. Finn MacCumhail and catch rider Ally Lazar, rode out with the red ribbon from the riders 13 and under qualifier. The amateur owned and trained country pleasure blue ribbon went back to Virginia with The King Of Wishful Thinking and Melanie Carroll, finishing just ahead of Cosmic Sunfire

and Judith Gandarillas.

The Novice Riders of all ages rode together in both their qualifier and championship classes. The tri-color from the championship was earned by What A Bonus and owner/rider Sarah Vaught, with the reserve championship title going to the winner of the Novice Rider class, Starmaker's Saturday Night, Amanda Baker riding for Madison Pleasant. CF Star At First Sight and Brittany Keel continued their competitive streak with their red ribbon finish in the Novice rider class.

The beautiful bay, Ro-Day-O, was driven by Annette Greene straight into the winner's circle from the country pleasure driving qualifier and championship. Manhattan Rose and Jasanalin Busenbark were reserve grand champions while Mountainview's Manhattan Discount and Lisa Jordan Pearce were reserve in the country pleasure driving class. Proving hard to beat in the Amateur Owned and Trained Hunter Country Pleasure classes was Symbol's Supreme Eclipse and Holly Henson. They were two for two at the North Carolina State Fair, followed both times out by The King Of Wishful Thinking and Melanie Carroll. Always enjoyed by the good-sized crowds of spectators that walk over from the fairgrounds are the Western Country Pleasure classes. Continuing their winning ways in the Western Country Pleasure Championship was the team of O Ain't I Somethin and Luanne Kilday. Popular reserve championship honors as well as the blue from the Junior Exhibitor Country Pleasure class was all for Rum Tum Tigger, shown by Luanne's son, Jeb Boyd. Luanne summed it up best after Mother and Son made their victory pass ... "all wins are special, some more special than others." Liquid Trust and Sarah Armstrong took home the bright red ribbon from the Junior Exhibitor Western Country Pleasure class of three. The always eye-catching Callaway's Son Of A Son and his beloved owner Alicia Patrick, made their victory pass from the Western Country Pleasure class, followed in reserve by O Ain't I Somethin and Luanne Kilday.
