Remarkably, she is one of three impressive three-year-olds to win World or National Championships for Theresa Vonderschmitt. At the World's Championship Horse Show in August 2008, Bob Brison rode two of her other stars, Sterling Price and Undulata's Health Nutt, to sweep both sections of the Three-Year-Old Stallion/Gelding World Championship.

Theresa Vonderschmitt and her B&T Vonderschmitt LLC own an impressive string of horses including WGC Manila Thrilla who was ridden by Theresa to the 2008 Amateur Ladies Three-Gaited Over 15.2 World's Championship. She also has a star in the five-gaited division in Reserve National Amateur Champion I'm Something Wicked. Other B&T Vonderschmitt LLC champions include Mr. Center Stage, Callaway's Unsolved Memories, Reserve World Champion Captain Kangaroo, Strike Up The Music, and Callaway's Born To Ride. All are trained by Bob and Tonya Brison's Fairview Farm in New Bloomfield, Missouri. Valerie Kron is the talented assistant to the Brisons.

Theresa Vonderschmitt, who resides in Jasper, Indiana, is obviously passionate about the American Saddlebred and her love for the breed is perhaps only matched by her generosity. Whether through donations to many, many horse shows or as a benefactor of a scholarship program at William Woods University, the American Saddlebred as a whole benefits from the philanthropic endeavors of Theresa Vonderschmitt.
