Gracing our January front cover is World and National Champion His Supreme Reflection. He is just a five-year-old with a long career ahead of him and yet the Supreme Heir son has already compiled a remarkable record. He was undefeated in 2007 winning all 13 of his park classes while showing at many of the nation's biggest horse shows including, of course, the Kentucky State Fair and UPHA American Royal. Each of those wins has been with Andy Freseth in the saddle, but before changing to the park division "Alec" was also very successful in fine harness as a three-year-old and was shown by Lynda Freseth.

Alec was owned from 2005-2007 by longtime Hollow Haven customers, Bob and Marilyn Gaiswinkler. The Gaiswinklers have owned numerous winning show horses including the one and only WCC CH Blackberry Delight who was shown by their daughter Erica Gaiswinkler Nelson from 2002-2004 and the beautiful team won a total of six world's champion titles. In 2001, CH Future Treasure and Erica won World Champions in the country pleasure division.

Currently Erica and CH Sue She (pictured above) are showing in the amateur three-gaited division and were Reserve National Grand Champions at the American Royal. Erica and her supportive husband Richard live in Derry, N.H. Although Erica's father Bob Gaiswinkler remains steadfastly supportive of his daughter's riding career, it is Marilyn Gaiswinkler whose passion for the American Saddlebred may be the strongest of the Saddlebred loving family.

His Supreme Reflection was recently purchased by Kim Jones of Newport Beach, Calif., and will be shown in 2008 under the Tom Swain Stables banner.
