Change is, as they say, a good thing, and that old adage was proven right once again as the 84th annual Blowing Rock Charity Horse Show moved the dates for their 2007 affair from early August to early June. Four hundred stalls were sold, and new show manager Ray Cloninger and dedicated show chairperson Susan Whittington, could not have been more proud and pleased with the turnout, not only in quantity, but in quality of horses shown. The show is a labor of love, and has for many years welcomed exhibitors, some from the second and third generations of their family, to show in the beautiful mountain air in this historic facility.

Exhibitors, trainers, owners, and their families, friends, and horse enthusiasts enjoy the daytime only schedule, leaving them time to visit at any number of nice local restaurants, shops, and, of course, the local ice cream shop and playground at the park. The local Chamber of Commerce could not have ordered more perfect weather for the entire four days of showing. Eighty's in the day, 60's at night, and when a dark cloud did appear in the distance, it seemed to go around the show grounds. After the rains of 2006, this show was due their good weather. I'm told June is traditionally a drier month in Blowing Rock than August ... and that's a good thing!

Generous sponsors once again stepped up to provide hospitality under the tent adjoining the show ring, each of the three afternoons, as well as the Championship Brunch early on Sunday morning. Delicious offerings

of food and beverage, and treats for the horses at all times, were a much anticipated highlight of this show again in 2007.

With a board of directors made up of people with the dedication and foresight that this one has displayed, it would appear this long running show has set off in a new direction with their change of dates. The 84th annual Blowing Rock Charity Horse Show enjoyed a banner year indeed. Come be a part of the 85th if you can!

Highlights of the divisions include...

Five-Gaited

CH Dusty Beau and trainer Lewis Eckard boldly raked and trotted their way into the winner's circle, finishing as the Five-Gaited Grand Champions and Five-Gaited Open Champions for proud owner Rebekah Cloninger. The very mannered French Resistance, shown by trainer Steve Gassen for Casey Surface, proudly took home reserve grand champion and champion honors to Holly Tree Stables' tack room. The eye-catching team of Our Silver Charm and George Anne Nash made their winning statement in both the Ladies and Amateur Five-Gaited Championship. Classic Native Dancer and Kathy Cook rode out with the red ribbon from the Ladies class, as did Shamrock's Free Step and Janelle D'Amato from the Amateur Cham-

ampionship. I'm Good and Imogene Lusk were indeed in blue ribbon form to top the Amateur Five-Gaited qualifier, just ahead of local favorites Pick Me First and Donna Lockett. Watching the new team of The Apprentice and Bree Zandy turn back the competition to win both the Junior Exhibitor Five-Gaited Championship and qualifier, was fun indeed. Hard riding competitors Bluebonnet's Wild Thing and Cara Wolf picked up reserve honors and their share of the applause from both Junior Exhibitor classes.

The Novice Five-Gaited class showcased the talents of The Witness, trainer Rick Felder in the irons for Jennifer Garison. Riva's Periapator and Morgan Feimster rode up for the red ribbon. An entertaining group of three Junior Five-Gaited horses answered the call for the Friday afternoon finale.

Catching the judge's eye for the title was the sporty Callaway's Credence, trainer Greg O'Kelley showing for Dr. Brian Garrett. Debuting to the bright red ribbon was the promising Lady Drifter, trainer Randy Cole doing the honors for All-Well Farm. Pimp My Ride and James Lawrence were the solo exhibitors in the Three-Year-Old Five-Gaited class. If you want to see a young rider just enjoying showing, step up to the rail when I Believe I Can Fly and young Sarah Martin are showing. They are making their mark on the Five-Gaited pony classes, and were Blowing Rock's Five-Gaited Pony Grand Champions and Champions, "flying solo".

Three-Gaited

The athletic Lunenburg's Irish Storm with trainer Catherine Jenkins in the irons, had the ring all to themselves to display their talent as Blowing Rock's Open and Three-Gaited Grand Champions. Let The Magic Begin and Megan Whitby, riding for Jeanne Frazer, had the ring all to themselves as well, and claimed the Junior Three-Gaited title. It was two for two at Blowing Rock in the Amateur Three-Gaited qualifier and Championship for the special performer Diamond Merchant, expertly shown by Allison Boozer. Periapator's Dancing Star and Dr. Teresa Miller took home reserve honors from both these Amateur classes. Many times champion WC CH

The Showstopper, added to his long list of wins with titles from the Junior Exhibitor Three-Gaited Championship and qualifier. Margaret Morrison is the proud owner and rider, under the Cash Lovell Stables banner. Mahvalous Asset and Caitlin Leith hung reserve ribbons from these two classes at the Ingleside Stables tack room. WCC CH Royalty In Black and Allie Wellington continued their winning ways at Blowing Rock with family cheering from both sides of the grandstand. Their double wins were from the good classes of Three-Gaited ponies.

Fine Harness

The versatile Finally Arrived caught the judge's eye in the Fine Harness Championship and emerged with the tricolor flying. Veteran of the show ring at Blowing Rock, trainer Neil Scruggs, was on the lines for proud owner Hannah Johnston. The up-and-coming Part Of My Charm had trainer Steve Joyce showing for Marian Hunt Bramlett to garner the Open Fine Harness blue, and finish as reserve grand champions. The lone entry competing in the Amateur Fine Harness class was A True Gentleman shown by Phillip Casenburg for Vicki Casenburg. Blowing Rock's Junior Fine Harness champion hailed from nearby Columbus, N.C. Owner, trainer, and exhibitor Carol Addison was all smiles as her name was called out as the

winner of this class of three. Heir To The Moon and trainer Suzy Shiflet showing for Lineshare Farm, drove out with the bright red ribbon.

Saddle Seat Equitation

Rachel Rafolski had the ring to herself to display her considerable talent and wear the title of Blowing Rock's Saddle Seat Equitation Grand Champion following her win of the UPHA Challenge Cup class for riders 17 and under, and a reserve finish in the Pleasure Equitation class of four.

Charming young Jennifer Roberts had a full to overflowing schedule of equitation classes at Blowing Rock. First she won the NHS Saddle Seat Event, then the Saddle Seat Equitation class for riders 14-17, the Pleasure Equitation class, and followed those up by winning the USEF Medal class. As the equitation rider who accumulated the most points in the Saddlebred Equitation division, she made a victory pass on Sunday afternoon and was presented a \$500 Scholarship to Stephens College by Caroline Shepard. This was the second year in a row for Jennifer to win this award.

Reserve in the NHS Saddle Seat Event went to Sally McEwen, with the reserve in the USEF Medal class to Callie Culbertson.

Four young dedicated equestrians made up the classes for the 10 and Under Walk and Trot Equitation riders

at Blowing Rock. Stephanie Brackett rode up for the Walk and Trot Equitation, Riders 10 and Under blue on Friday, Cagle James in reserve. Cagle James made the victory pass from Saturday afternoon's UPHA 10 and Under Equitation Walk and Trot class, with Stephanie in reserve.

Harness and Hackney Pony

The athletic Willowood Balladeer had Charles Leonard in the viceroy for owner Bill Weavil, as they proved the ones to beat in both the Hackney Pony Open and Championship classes at Blowing Rock. Heartland Bandelero and Dr. Gary Garison, showing for G&I Broodmare Farm, Inc., took home reserve honors from both classes.

The Harness Pony Championship and Open class were another tricolor turn of the track for the elegant Fitz's Mademoiselle, shown in the Championship by another longtime Blowing Rock exhibitor, and proud owner, Mrs. Landon Eckard. Rebekah Cloninger did the qualifying honors on Thursday.

Three-Gaited Park

Not the largest classes of the show, but certainly some of the most competitive, were the classes for the three-gaited park horses. Sunday afternoon's Open Three-Gaited Park Championship saw the colorful Caramaya catch the judge's eye for the tricolor, owner/trainer Nancy Troutman in the irons. They had finished reserve Thursday in the Open qualifier. The sporty Jewels To Go! had trainer Greg O'Kelley showing for Dr. Brian Garrett, to finish reserve in the Championship. New to the division is the world's champion harness horse Catalytic. Trainer Evan Orr put this athletic youngster under saddle this winter with blue ribbon results from Thursday's Open Park qualifier for proud owner Susan Hollowell. The park horse to beat over and over this young season has been Bongo, owned by Amy Hunt Roberts, and shown at Blowing Rock by Ginger Reagan in the Amateur Park classes, garnering the tricolor and blue ribbons, much to the delight of the Chestnut Lane cheering section. The consistent team of CH Callaway's B. Gratz Brown and Karin Banks were popular reserve grand champions and champions. Miss Kit Cat and proud owner/rider Erin Bolster made their blue ribbon outing in the Three-Gaited Park Junior Horse class Saturday, just ahead of Petal 'N Lace and Vickie Casenburg. The good com-

petition I mentioned earlier was in abundance in the Junior Exhibitor Three-Gaited Park class of nine for the qualifier and seven for the Championship. The hard to beat team of My Mountain Heirs and good riding Rebekah Cloninger were at the top of their game both classes for two more ribbons to decorate the tack room at Drowning Creek Farm. Taking home reserve champion and grand champion titles was Absolute Proof and Dabney Hoffman for Little Cahaba Properties.

Pleasure Pony, Pleasure Pony Driving and Leadline

The ageless Santana's Flaming Dawn, a champion for each child who has ridden her, is now bringing smiles to Alex Ennis. "Ellen" and Alex had two top rides in Blowing Rock, taking back a blue and tricolor to the Ingleside Farm tack room. The competitive team of Walterway's Mighty Hi Falutin and Tiara Terra took reserve honors on this weekend back to Jon Walker Stables.

The delightful team of Wait & See's Postmaster and Alexandra Foster were two for two on the sunny weekend at Blowing Rock in their Pony Pleasure driving qualifier and championship, showing under the instruction of Cash Lovell Stables. The brand new team of Believe It! and Susan Whittington drove away with reserve honors from both Pony Pleasure driving classes.

Riders of tomorrow having a grand time in their Lead Line class Sunday afternoon were Paige Cooper, Mailee Dudan, Ladd Jackson, Maureen Kelly, and Cashlyn Lovell.

Roadster Horse

The hard driving team of Eclipse and Steve Deutsch came to Blowing Rock on a mission. When the Roadster Horse Championship was tied Sunday afternoon, their mission was accomplished. Not only did they win Friday's Amateur Roadster to Bike class but the Roadster Horse Championship and the very very special trophy that goes with it...The Johnny Wellington Memorial Perpetual Trophy given in loving memory of Johnny by the Drowning Creek Farm family. Adding two more titles to their long and impressive list was the top performer Cappuccino, Brenda Kelly showing him to the Amateur Roadster Pony Champion and Amateur Grand Champion titles. Rant N Rave K.V. and Karen Voerg took reserve honors from the Amateur qualifier and amateur championship home to Cumming, Ga.

A determined and talented group of Junior Exhibitors showed their ponies in Blowing Rock. WC Zildjian had good driving Caitlin Leith in the bike to win the Junior Exhibitor Roadster Pony Championship before a good crowd Sunday, in addition to the Junior Exhibitor qualifier on Friday. The new team of Lone Star and Lindsay Jones moved up a ribbon from the qualifier to finish as Reserve Grand Champions on Sunday afternoon. WC Perfect Offering and Jake Butts were a popular reserve in the Junior Exhibitor class before showing in their Under Saddle classes. The AHHS Road Pony Medallion class for the Junior Exhibitor featured a new pony to the area in the winner's circle. Do'ing Time and Dustin Lassett, showing for Steve Edwards, finished ahead of Heartland Wild Thunder and Jeb Boyd. Another new team having a grand time when they show is WC Perfect Offering and Jake Butts. They went to the Road Pony Under Saddle winner's circle twice at Blowing Rock, with Jake smiling all the way, much to the delight of proud grandmom, Sharon Anderson. Sugar Daddy and Crystal Case were reserve in the AHHS Roadster Pony Under Saddle Medallion class, while John Glenn had Nikki

Friesian, Halter and Trainers Equitation

The big, black, and beautiful Friesian horses are a crowd pleaser wherever they show. Blowing Rock was no exception. Proving hard to beat again was Tessa Van De Zuiderwaard, shown in victory both in the Open and Championship by her special rider, Ashley Walker. Making their presence felt in the division is the new team of Hoera Boszorg II, shown by Kelsey Baird. They were reserve in both classes of four. Inne and trainer Cheryl Baird had the ring to themselves for the Friesian Walk-Trot Pleasure win on Thursday afternoon. Friday afternoon Tessa Van De Zuiderwaard showed her versatility, as she did in a Friesian Pleasure Driving exhibition, Bill Jackson and Pam Jackson in the buggy.

Adding variety to the show schedule were the two Halter classes, one for horses four and under, the second for horses five and over. Savannah's Wish and Sheila Winger for Susan Whittington caught the judge's eye in the Halter, four and under class ahead of Desdemona's Affair and Ashlin Bryan. Stevie Nicks, shown by Erin Bolster for Cherry Stone Farm LLC, was the one to beat in the Halter, horses five and over class, with reserve to Shamrock's Free Step and Janelle D'Amato.

When it came to the last class Saturday afternoon, i.e., the Trainers Equitation class, it was packed around the ring. This is the class where many trainers, eight this year, let their hair down, so to speak. As entertaining as it was from the rail, I feel sure Judge Nancy Becker had lots to see. After many changes of gaits both ways of the ring, and a lot of roaring from the crowd, not to mention Jon Walkers' unique style of showing, Lewis Eckard took home the blue, followed by Jo Cornell and daughter, Midge Hunt, in a tie for reserve. You simply had to be there for this class!

Show Pleasure

The adult three-gaited show pleasure classes were full of quality entries. Add to that the wide variety of qualifying classes that were held for the adult championship, and you understand the decision by management to split the adult championship Sunday afternoon. Thursday afternoon's adult class featured 18 entries. The new team

of Reedann's Phine By Me and Marion Bryan finished in the winner's circle to lots of applause from her cheering section, followed closely by Mountainview's Truly Amazing and Dr. Kim Blackwell. Saturday afternoon's Show Pleasure Limit Horse class of 14 was a great one to watch as well. Another new team proved the ones to beat this time out...Heavy Hitter and Mary Dunker show lots of promise for the future. Knocking on the door for reserve in the Limit class was Miraculous Odds and Lauren Camp DeHaan. Then you had eight entries in the Novice Rider Pleasure class...a showcase for the consistent Mojave, Rachel Pahnky in the irons and smiling all the way, with reserve to Emanating and Dr. Melinda Snyder. Sunday afternoon's Adult Championship then had two divisions...Division A featured Woulda Coulda Shoulda and Aimee Austin wearing the tricolor, just ahead of the new team of She's Extra Charming and Carol Love. Division B was another special moment for the new partners Reedann's Phine By Me and Marion Bryan, reserve to Endolane Symphony and Ginger Roseman, riding for Anna Roseman.

The two age groups of Junior Exhibitors and their pleasure horses had good numbers and quality as well. The Championship for riders 14-17 showcased the talents of the picture perfect Americana's Wing's, Paige Pennington in the irons, following their reserve in the riders 14-17 qualifier. Local favorites The Cash Connection and Ciara Horton made their cheering section proud with their reserve in the championship. The sporty Irene's Goodnight Kiss and Georgia Rae Gurney took the blue from the riders 14-17 qualifier back to Suzy Shiflet's tack room. Proving again to be the ones to beat in the pleasure classes for riders 13 and under, was the one-of-a-kind performer CH It's Yabba Dabba Doo Time shown to both wins by talented Allie Wellington. Many many times champion CH Trapp Mountain and Marcy Richards took reserve honors from the championship back to Marjorie Judd Stables' tack room. Reserve in the riders 13 and under qualifier went back to Cheryl Baird Stables with Callaway's Letter To The Editor and Erin Ohning.

The Junior Park Pleasure class Friday afternoon was call for celebration back at Cheryl Baird Stables again as Belle

Splendor and Cheryl riding for the Mary Goforth Trust, turned back the competition to make the victory pass, just ahead of Just Like That and Midge Hunt for Little River Farm LLC. Continuing their winning season in the Open Park Pleasure classes was the special entertainer CF Not Tonight Chief, Erica Savary in the irons for proud owner Lisa Austin. The Blowing Rock results were two classes, two blues. Reserve in the Open Park Pleasure Championship was all for Showboat's Casablanca, shown by trainer Steve Joyce for Marian Hunt Bramlett. The bright red ribbon from the open qualifier went back to Paul Boone Stables with My Tee Time and Andrea Everett.

CH Empress In Black continued her successful career in the Walk and Trot Pleasure classes for riders 12 and Under at Blowing Rock. This time it was six-year-old Allie Poovey in the irons, smiling all the way. This team rode away with the tricolor from the Championship Sunday afternoon, much to the delight of her large cheering section. Nina Rivera was presented the red ribbon for reserve. In the Walk and Trot qualifier, the blue and victory pass was all for Meghan Crider, reserve to Madison McCall. A new class at Blowing Rock 2007 was the Walk and Trot Pleasure class for riders 55 and over. Gwen Frangias was back in the ring again for this blue ribbon turn of the track aboard Inne. The tireless Janell D'Amato had Jansal Saddlebreds, LLC's I Walk Alone in blue ribbon form for both the Hunter/Sport Horse Pleasure wins.

Looking the part of a champion was I'm An Early Riser, owner/driver Mary Lynn McMains on the lines, to top both the Show Pleasure Driving classes in grand style. Marjorie Judd trains this team. Moneta, Virginia's own Pat Yeatts, was in the cart behind her eye-catching Stevie Nicks to finish a popular reserve in both show pleasure driving classes. Callaway's Maelstrom and Caitlin Leith seemed to enjoy their winning drive in the ASHAF Youth Pleasure Driving class. Worthy's Just Once and Alexandra Foster took reserve back to Cash Lovell Stables from this field of two.

Good competition was also seen in the adult and junior exhibitor five-gaited pleasure classes. CH Social Worth, Pam Austin showing, and Seajay Lewis, Dr. Brian Garrett aboard, dueled for the victory from the adult

qualifier and Championship. Seajay Lewis and Dr. Brian Garrett made the Championship victory pass and was reserve in the qualifier. CH Social Worth made the qualifier victory pass and was reserve in the Championship...stay tuned, I'm sure they will meet each other in the show ring again soon. New as a team in the Junior Exhibitor Five-Gaited classes are Sunken Treasure and determined young Drew Taylor Hewitt. Their record at Blowing Rock was two for two, much to the delight of their large cheering section. Always there making their presence felt in these classes are CH Callaway's No Problem and Dustin Lassett. Blowing Rock was no exception, as they finished reserve both times out.

Country Pleasure

The many times champion CH Riva Diva and Donna Finch continued to be an item at Blowing Rock, winning both the large Adult Country Pleasure classes in style. Some horse/rider combinations just fit, and this is one of those teams. The new team of A Promise Keeper and Pam Quick are making their presence felt in the division as well. They took reserve champion and grand champion honors out of the ring. Two shows in a row and two Novice Rider Country Pleasure blues is the record for Strike Up The Lights and the young up-and-comer, Caitlin Hucker. They were followed in reserve by Commet's Second Chance, owned and shown by Ashlin Page Bryan. As they have done some many times, Harlem's Knight At The Apollo and Luanne Kilday trotted into the winner's circle as the AOT Country Pleasure champions, followed closely for reserve by Highpoint's Fancy Cat and Toree Lewis-Hefner.

In blue ribbon form for the titles of Junior Exhibitor, ages 14-17, Country Pleasure Grand Champion and Champion, was the photogenic team of Callaway's Blue Agate and Emily Burglass. Strike Up The Lights and Caitlin Hucker, showing for Lesley Orr, were a good reserve in the Championship class of eight, while CH Wing's Main Attraction and Adrienne Fitch picked up the red ribbon from the qualifier Friday afternoon. The perfectly mannered Callaway's Passport was catch ridden to the Junior Exhibitor Country Pleasure Championship for riders 13 and under, by Alli Smith, this following their reserve finish in the riders 13 and under qualifying

class. Undulata's Man Of Hour Dreams was catch ridden by Hanna Norwood to a blue ribbon finish in the Junior Exhibitor, riders 13 and under, qualifier, finishing as reserve grand champions on this Sunday afternoon. It was back to back wins in the Western Country Pleasure class as well as the Western Country Pleasure Championship for O Ain't I Somethin', good riding Luanne Kilday in the saddle both times out. Heir Cooled and Sallie Turner took reserve placing back home to Buford, Ga., from both classes. CH Dr. Deker was catch driven in both the country pleasure driving classes to perfection by Susan Hollowell, with blue and tricolor results. Highpoint's Fancy Cat and Toree Lewis-Hefner showed their versatility doing both riding and driving at Blowing Rock. They finished as reserve Country Pleasure Driving Champions and Grand Champions.
