This year's Midwest Charity Horse Show was dedicated to Patrick Antonacci, a familiar face and longtime supporter of the horse show. Whether volunteering or cheering on his children and friends in the show ring, Patrick Antonacci could always be seen around the show grounds and always made this request of his children when showing, "Just go out there, have fun and smile," which is advice we can all take to heart. They also gave out the Patrick Antonacci Tack Room Award for the first time this year. Bret Day's Greyridge won the Neat and Tidy Award while Scott Matton's Knollwood won the award for the best Formal Tack Room. The Antonacci family also sponsored the Show Pleasure Driving Championship, in memory of their patriarch.

Many new teams hit their stride at Midwest this year, and many familiar teams continued to dominate. The show gets more and more competitive each year and has turned into a warmup of sorts for Lexington Junior League and the World's Championship Horse Show. Competition was deep in all divisions as top horses and riders from all over the country show up to compete for the blue. Now, let's get on with the show.

Five-Gaited

The Five-Gaited division saw plenty of deep competition throughout the week, and the Open division was no exception. The white faced exciting star Platinum's New Look, aka "Tonto," made two thrilling shows with extreme brilliance and strong balanced gaits. Now piloted by Todd Miles, this star could not be denied the win in both the Five-Gaited Championship and the earlier Stallion/ Gelding qualifier. Reserve honors in both classes went to the fancy chestnut Catamaran with Mitch Clark in the irons. Callaway's Unsolved Mystery reigned supreme over the Five-Gaited Mares, winning the Open class with Bob Brison aboard. She's A

Red Hot Chili Pepper looked better than ever to earn the second place ribbon with Richard Obenauf up. Every one of these horses is a potential strong competitor for the big crown in August.

Thirteen talented entries hit the ring for the Five-Gaited Novice Horse class. In the end, Bret Day had the handsome Major Starbuck moving high and light for the win. The red ribbon went to the slick moving Contender's Citation and Virgil Helm.

The Junior division was well represented with ten youngsters showing up for the Five-Gaited Junior class. Andy Freseth expertly piloted the expressive and exquisite Catalyst's Work Of Art to the unanimous win. Todd Miles and the impressive Pour Some Sugar On Me racked and trotted up a storm to earn the reserve honors. Jim Lowry showed the amazing Major Buck to the blue in the Five-Gaited Three-Year-Old class. The red ribbon went to the Impressive Do You Dare and Louis Louw. The three-year-olds were also the focus in the UPHA Five-Gaited Three-Year-Old Classic with Ylang Ylang and Bob Brison racking away with the victory. The red ribbon went to Reedann's Heir To Glory and Louis Louw.

CH Callaway's Born To Win and his beloved rider Gayle Lampe ruled the Five-Gaited Ladies division with divine expression, high and fluid strides, and impeccable manners. They won the unanimous victory honors in both the Championship and the earlier qualifier. The reserve Championship honors

went to the polished Sixes And Sevens and Paula Briney. CH Harlem's Hot Ticket and Neva Van Ess earned the reserve honors in the qualifier.

Likewise, Swish and Carol Hillenbrand made a similar sweep of the Five-Gaited Amateur division winning both the Championship and the earlier qualifier with their trademark style and flair. Theresa Vonderschmitt and her outrageously talented Red Flame Thrower earned the reserve tricolor after making stunning passes. The red ribbon in the qualifier went to the pretty and powerful What's The Whoopla and Karen Coup. Jerome Radar and his fantastic I'm Something Wicked have really hit their stride together and made a thrilling show to earn the unanimous win in the Five-Gaited Amateur Gentlemen's class. Tippy Gypsy and Gabe Deknatel made a fabulous show for reserve honors.

The Five-Gaited Amateur Ladies were well represented also as the new team of Bono and Linda Fischer Wheeler lit up the ring as they trotted and racked their way to the blue in both the Championship and the qualifier. The slick and synchronized team of Already Famous and Luanne Kilday earned a strong reserve in both classes.

The Five-Gaited Junior Exhibitor class was split into two qualifiers, one for riders 13 and under and one for riders 14 to 17. Brittany McGinnis and her sensational Carolina Cat earned the Championship tricolor as well as the 14 to 17 qualifier. The reserve Championship honors went to

Callaway's Lil Abner and Faye Wuesthofen after a great ride. Independence Day and Victoria McCune earned the red ribbon in the 14 to 17 qualifier. Nick Neviasser and CH Harlem's Hot Ticket racked away with the blue in the 13 and under qualifier. Take A Guess and Morgan Brison made a great show for the red ribbon.

Three-Gaited

The Three-Gaited Open Championship was light in number but deep in quality. A.J. Bruwer piloted the refined beauty Liberty's Magic to the tricolor after an earlier second place finish in the Under 15.2 qualifier. Caroline Skinner stepped up her game and earned the reserve tricolor with her sensational CH Royal Messenger. A.J. Bruwer also piloted the handsome (SA) The Engraver to the win in the Over 15.2 qualifier. Thunder Cloud Nine and Todd Miles made a stunning winning ride in the Under 15.2 qualifier. The fancy Desert's Supreme Dream made a winning show with Jack Magill aboard to win the Three-Gaited Novice Horse class. Reserve honors went to the elegant Hero's Forever Ablaze and Missy Hughes.

Robert Gardiner is certainly proving himself as a top young trainer, and he showed the beautiful black Harlem's Showman to the unanimous win in the Three-Gaited Junior Horse class. The fine High Time's Northern Son and Max Ciampoli made a terrific show for the red ribbon. The refined and elegant team of Always Remembered and Tracy James made a truly memorable show to earn the unanimous win in the Three-Gaited Three-Year-Old class. Man Of Liberty and Jennifer Townsend made a stellar show for the reserve honors. The 15 horse strong UPHA Three-Gaited Three-Year-Old Classic saw the exhilarating Glenview's Excelalante and Chuck Herbert make the unanimous winning ride. James Lowry piloted another thrilling star, Stonecroft Nightlight, to the reserve honors.

The Three-Gaited Ladies division saw two top stars battle it out, Marching Orders and Barbara Goodman-Manilow and Sue-She and Ericka Nelson. Both of these horses are entirely different as Marching Orders moves with a strong and powerful park trot while Sue-She moves with elegance and refinement. Both are equally grand with manners to spare. In the end, Marching Orders and

Barbara Goodman-Manilow came out on top in both the qualifier and Championship with Sue-She and Ericka Nelson in reserve in both classes. They are truly two shining teams in this division.

The sensational New York's Perfect Gift and Betsy Thomas ruled the Three-Gaited Amateur division, unanimsly winning both the Championship and the Over 15.2 qualifier. Reserve honors in both classes went to the tremendous team of Manilla Thrilla and Theresa Vonderschmitt. Carolina's Top Gun and Kerry Ann Bunde made the winning ride in the Under 15.2 qualifier. The classy Enough About You and Lynda Norman made a great show for the reserve ribbon.

Freakness and Ellyn Dorsey showed both manners and motion to win the Three-Gaited Amateur Ladies Championship after a second place finish in the earlier qualifier. Reserve honors in the Championship went to the classy and elegant CH Callaway's Merry-Go-Round and Christy Bennett, who made the winning ride in the qualifier.

(SA) Nelmar's Tango 4 Ever and Emily Scharpf made a clean sweep of the Three-Gaited Junior Exhibitor division unanimsly winning the Championship and the qualifier for riders 14 to 17. Reserve Championship honors went to the lovely Lady Cinnamon and Maya Manilow, who also earned the red ribbon in the 13

and under qualifier. I'm Bewitched and Sarah Singer earned the second place honors in the 14 to 17 qualifier. The adorable and powerful team of The Attache Orchid and Hunter Chancellor earned a resounding win in the 13 and under qualifier.

Fine Harness

The Fine Harness division was well filled and full of quality. John Conatser and the dark beauty Gone Platinum made a sweep of the Open Fine Harness division, unanimsly winning both the Open Championship and the Open qualifier. Reserve honors in both classes went to the fancy I'm A Lucky Star and Mike Roberts.

The Junior division was chock full of talented rising stars, and Bret Day drove the fabulous Open Arms to the unanimous win in the Junior class. The red ribbon went to the lovely Alicia Silverstone and Pat McConnell. Richard Obenauf drove the winning entries in both of the Three-Year-Old classes, winning the UPHA Fine Harness Three-Year-Old Classic with Ginger Blossom and the Three-Year-Old class with The New York Look. Reserve honors in the UPHA Classic went to Ribbons And Reins and Carter Cox. The second place honors in the Three-Year-Old class went to Father MacKenzie and Mike Roberts. Carter Cox knows how to start a young harness horse like no other, and he proved his talent and skill as he drove the balanced and square Simbara's

Sandcastle to the blue in the Two-Year-Old class. James Lowry and Sir Raymond Ross made a great show for the red ribbon.

CH Kalarama's New Sensation has truly lived up to his name over the past few years, and Mary Gise expertly drove him to the win in both the extremely competitive Fine Harness Amateur Championship and the qualifier. Reserve honors in both classes went to the elegant combination of Lady Vol and Chris Kaplan.

The ASHA Foundation Junior Exhibitor Driving Challenge classes are a great way to get young people involved with driving and it is wonderful to see. Brittany Baird drove her mother's star CH Cary's Moonraker to the blue in the Fine Harness Challenge showing good hands and poise. The red ribbon went to Catrin and the skilled Patsy Loeb.

Show and Country Pleasure

The Pleasure division is always large and deep in the Midwest with every class full of talented horse and rider teams. She's Gone Blonde and Lisa Duncan burned brightly in the Adult Five-Gaited Show Pleasure division unanimsly winning both their large qualifier and Championship, which were the two largest classes of the week. This team is one to watch for as they showed with brilliance, style, and impeccable manners. The reserve Championship honors went to Doubletrees Quixotic with Kurt Antonacci catch-riding for Vicky Reed. The red ribbon in the qualifier went to the strong new team of Husker Du and Tom D. Pettry. The Junior Exhibitors were just as competitive with Inphalible and Lori Jordan racking their way to the Five-Gaited Show Pleasure Junior Exhibitor Championship tricolor. Reserve Championship honors went to the winners of the qualifier, the fantastic The Champagne Tiger and Claire Talley. Ridgefield's Excessive and Andrew Slater made a fabulous show for the second place honors in the qualifier.

The Three-Gaited Show Pleasure Adult division was so large that two qualifiers were offered that led to one large and exciting Championship. CH Ninety-Eight Degrees and Susan Creekmore made the winning Championship ride, and they are truly a great new team. The fancy combination of CH Uncle Abe and Piper Granger made a strong show for reserve in both the Championship and

the qualifier for riders 18 to 38. The bay beauty CH My Grande and Amanda Dellinger captured the blue in qualifier for riders 18 to 38. The exciting new team of Teuschers and Barbara Goodman-Manilow rode off with the blue in the qualifier for riders 39 and over. CH Just Special and Carol Hillenbrand made another of their mannerly and stylish shows for the second place honors.

This show supports the local area and offered pleasure classes for Illinois Residents. Another new team, the elegant First Class Heir and Glenn T. Werry, dominated the Three-Gaited Show Pleasure Illinois Resident qualifier and Championship. Reserve Championship honors went to the athletic Square Dance and Cathy Klasek. The Three-Gaited Show Pleasure Novice Amateur class was offered for the Novice riders, and CH Laguardia carried yet another rider to a blue ribbon as Eva Heniges piloted him to victory. Perazzi and Sarah Keil made an excellent show for the red ribbon.

The Junior Horse division was represented as well with a qualifying class and a Championship, both of which were won by the handsome Callaway's Investigative Reporter and Eileen Nemetz. The reserve tricolor went to the aptly named He's Got It All and Lauren Bohne. Phoebe Hanson and Claudia Gardiner Sipp earned reserve honors in the earlier qualifier.

The Three-Gaited Show Pleasure Junior Exhibitor division saw two separate Championships and qualifiers based on a rider's age. The grand gentleman CH Blackberry Delight unanimously won both the Championship and the qualifier for riders 14 to 17 with Rachel Machamer aboard. Reserve honors in both classes went to the stylish The Grandmaster and Thea Ervin. CH Wind Cruzer and Callie Smith made a clean sweep of their division as well winning both blues in the 13 and under qualifier and Championship. The reserve tricolor went to the stellar team of CF First Light Of Dawn and Maya Manilow. CH Star Spangled Steel and Ashley Baird emerged from the qualifier with the red ribbon after a fantastic show.

The exquisite CH Shot With Glory and Elizabeth James-Lipscomb reigned over the Show Pleasure Driving division by winning both their

The red ribbon went to equally good The Mystery Machine and Nick Neviaser.

The Country Pleasure division was just as competitive as CH The Shadow Knows and Linda Meyer continued to dominate the Three-Gaited Country Pleasure Adult division winning both the Championship and the qualifier. The reserve Championship honors went to the sparkling new team of Concrete Blonde and Kristin Pettry. Reserve honors in the qualifier went to the fabulous CH Catch The Fever and Sally Pavel. A Three-Gaited Country Pleasure Illinois Resident class was offered as well, which saw Concrete Blonde and Kristin Pettry make the victory pass. The red ribbon went to

the pretty Salt Heir and Nancy Berger. League Of Nations and Emily Druckman swept the Junior Exhibitor division unanimously winning both their qualifier and Championship. The red ribbon in both classes went to the pretty and refined team of He Walks On Water and Sarah Werry.

CH Callaway's Pretty Penny and Nancy Anderson proved they are the queens of the Country Pleasure Driving division, unanimously winning both their Championship and their qualifier. Eddie Lewis had Hitman's Special Delivery looking fantastic to win the reserve tricolor. Reserve honors in the qualifier went to the fancy CH Hard Day's Night TS, expertly catch-driven by Brendan Heintz.

Luanne Kilday had her Oh Ain't I Something in fine form to jog away with the blues in the Western Country Pleasure Championship and qualifier. This magnificent horse seems destined to follow in the footsteps of Kilday's previous Western star, Rum Tum Tigger. The reserve tricolor went to the talented Harlem's Mojo and Toni Nastali. CH Impressive Ruler and Mary Strohfus earned the reserve ribbon in the qualifier after a great show. *Saddle & Bridle's* Shatner Western Pleasure class was won by the lovely Magic Ovation and Amy Weller. King's Lady In Black and Tom Neese jogged away with the red ribbon.

Rosemarie Wheeler and her gorgeous CH May Issue made the fantastic winning ride in the Walk and Trot Only Pleasure 10 and Under class. The beautiful Friesian Arend F and Alex Nelson made the winning ride in the Open English Pleasure Stake after a strong second place finish in the qualifier. CH Bi Mi Add Lib and Kendra Fisher earned the reserve tricolor as well as the blue in the qualifier.

Park and Park Pleasure

The elegant and powerful His Supreme Reflection proved his supremacy indeed as Andy Freseth piloted him to two unanimous wins, one in the Park Horse Championship and one in the Open qualifier. Reserve honors in both classes went to the lovely Gotcha Covered and Kent Swalla. Robert Gardiner graced the winner's circle again, this time with the rising star Magilla Gorilla in the Junior Park Horse class. Second place honors went to Mac's Blue Attack and Max Ciampoli.

Todd Miles piloted the exquisite Fool For You to the win in the Park Pleasure Junior Horse class. The Rock Star and John Conatser made their mark for the second place ribbon. The UPHA Classic Park Pleasure class was unanimously won by the refined and mannerly Fanciful Heir SS and Tom Thorpe. John Conatser earned the red ribbon on the pretty Proof Perfect.

Equitation

The Saddle Seat Equitation division was intense and competitive with many top riders. The Senior Saddle Seat Equitation Championship saw five entries who all performed the rail and individual work. The workout was as follows: From the ingate, trot to point A. Stop and pivot to point B. Canter the first half of a straight line to B on the right lead. Trot the second half of the straight line to point B on

the right diagonal. Stop and pivot to point C. Canter the first half of a straight line to C on the left lead. Trot the second half of the straight line to point C on the left diagonal. Drop your stirrup irons and trot down the rail on the right diagonal and return to the line up. In the end, Meaghan McQueen prevailed as she earned the tricolor after strong and graceful rail and individual work. The reserve tricolor went to the poised Brittany McGinnis. Ellen Medley Wright made the winning ride in the qualifier with Rachel Machamer in second.

The Junior Saddle Seat Equitation division was just as competitive and extremely well filled. Only four of the seven in the Championship were asked to perform the individual workout which follows: Starting at the in gate end, divide the straight away into thirds. Trot the first third on the correct diagonal and continue trotting a circle to the left. Canter the second third of the straight away and continue cantering a circle to the left. Trot the final third on the left diagonal. Stop and reverse. Trot back down the rail and return to the line up. Taylor Newton, the winner of the earlier qualifier, earned the unanimous win in the Championship with beautiful rail and individual work. The reserve tricolor went to the skilled Abigail Mutrux. Reserve honors in the qual-

ifier went to the talented Callie Smith.

Taylor Newton also earned the blue in the NHS Saddle Seat Event, or "Good Hands," class. Reserve honors went to the talented Faye Wuesthofen. Brittany McGinnis earned the win in the USEF Medal class, which was asked to perform the following workout: Trot to the far end of the ring and execute a sandwich figure eight, cantering the first and fourth circles, trotting the second and third. Return to the line up at the trot. The red ribbon went to the lovely Meaghan MacQueen.

The UPHA Challenge Cup classes saw lots of great entries. Lauren McMichael had stellar rail and individual work to earn the win in the UPHA Adult Challenge Cup. Reserve honors went to Kevin Ingram. Faye Wuesthofen rode off with the blue in the UPHA Challenge Cup for riders 14 to 17 years old. The UPHA Challenge Cup 13 and Under class went to Belle Owen with the skilled Caroline Skinner in second. The UPHA Challenge Cup Walk/Trot 10 and Under class was won by the polished Kaitlyn Creekmore, who also won the 10 and Under Walk/Trot Stake. Rosemarie Wheeler earned the second place honors in the Challenge Cup class after a great show. Reserve honors in the Walk/Trot Stake went to Ariana Cerecedes.

The Pleasure Equitation riders performed just as well as their counterparts on the trimmed horses, and 11 riders showed up to compete in the Pleasure Equitation Championship. Four entries were asked to perform the individual workout, which was as follows: From the in gate end, perform a sandwich serpentine. Trot the first loop on the right diagonal. Canter the second loop on the right lead and continue cantering a circle and a half. Canter the third loop on the left lead and continue cantering a circle and a half. Trot the last loop on the left diagonal and return down the rail to the line up at the show trot. Victoria McHenry, fresh off of her Rock Creek wins, made the winning ride in the Championship after an earlier second place finish in the qualifier for riders 14 to 17. Nick Maupin earned the reserve tricolor as well as the win in the 13 and under qualifier. Mallory Hartigan showed poise and class to earn the blue in the 14 to 17 qualifier. Caroline Moeller made a good ride for reserve in the 13 and under class.

Corey O'Brian made the winning

Halt. Reverse and back. Trot back down the straight away and return to the line up. Angela Darrow showed the requisite poise and skill to earn the blue. The red ribbon went to Ashley Loethen.

Hackney/Harness Ponies

Regal's Trademark LF and Jeff McClean drove off with the blue in the Hackney Pony Championship after a strong second place finish in the Open qualifier. The reserve tricolor went to Heartland Candidate and Sandra Surber. Mary Campbell drove her lovely Nabucco to the win in the earlier qualifier. The Limit class was won by Heartland Alluring and Dr. Alan Raun. Heartland Alluring appeared in the show ring again, winning the Hackney Pony, Lady Driver class with owner Deborah Jahn at the lines.

The exquisite Heartland Elise was expertly driven by Mary Gaylord McClean, who earned the unanimous victory in both the Hackney Pony Amateur Championship and qualifier. The reserve tricolor went to Heartland Alluring and Deborah Jahn. The reserve honors in the qualifier went to the elegant Royal Canadian and Muffy

Ernster.

Maureen Lydon drove the aptly named Dunhaven Phenomenal to the win in the Hackney Harness Pony Championship after a strong win in the earlier Limit class. Impress My Daddy and Glenn T. Werry sure did impress as they earned the reserve tricolor and the blue in the Open qualifier. The second place honors in the Limit class went to Wait & See's Winter Day and Randy Wells. Creation's Windstar and Lynn Durant made the winning drive in the Ladies class. Conqueror's Colleen LF and Mary Ellen Golich had a great show for the red ribbon.

The Hackney Harness Pony Junior class was unanimously won by the handsome Twin Willow's Remington and Maureen Lydon. The red ribbon went to Seychelle and Mitch Clark. Mastercraft's Promoter LF and Tom Lowry made the winning drive in UPHA Classic Hackney Harness Pony, 4 and Under class. Heartland Expectation and Darrel Kolkman were a strong reserve.

The refined Shake Don't Stir and Mary Gaylord McClean swept the Hackney Harness Pony Amateur division winning both the Championship and the earlier qualifier. Reserve honors in both classes went to the gentlemanly new team of Señor and Perry Grieme. Lightning Up and Patsy Loeb earned the blue in the AHHS Youth Medallion, Hackney or Harness Pony, Junior Exhibitor class.

The Hackney or Harness Pony

Pleasure Driving division was very competitive as well with Wait & See's Raspberry and Donna Beck driving off with the Championship tricolor. Reserve honors in the Championship and qualifier went to the colorful Cherry Royale and Judy Kjellander. The blue in the qualifier went to the lovely Man On The Town and Mary Campbell. The Limit class was won by Wild Iris and Kurt Antonacci.

The UPHA Classic Hackney or Harness Pony Pleasure Driving, 4 Years and Under class was won by the mannerly and pretty Heartland Fortune Maker and Darrel Kolkman. The reserve honors went to Extreme Supreme and Glenn T. Werry, who also earned the red ribbon in the Hackney or Harness Pony Pleasure Driving Junior Pony class.
