Many New England barns close out their show season at the Octoberfest Horse show. If you are not heading to Harrisburg or the Royal, Octoberfest is your last appearance in the show ring for the year. Octoberfest also hosts the Academy Championships. In order to compete you must have shown in two or more tournaments throughout the year. What a way to close out the season! Since its inception, the show has been immensely popular with exhibitors throughout the Northeast. The fall season, with Halloween just around the corner, allows a break from the traditional. Barns get into the spirit by accenting the usual stable drapes and plants, with ghosts, goblins, spiders, scarecrows, and corn stalks. The week starts off on Wednesday night with the traditional set-up pizza party sponsored by Phoenix Stables. Friday night brings pies and apple crisps. The real fun begins on Saturday; in between the afternoon and evening sessions the traditional costume class takes place. Some of the more memorable groups from this year were RMD Stables as a race car pit crew, Lukens Stables as the Addams Family and Cater Stables as the New England Patriot cheerleaders. After the costume class there is trick or treating for the kids in the barns. All of the barns participate with bowls

and bowls of candy. The influx of sugar in the late afternoon helps to keep everyone up and going for the progressive aisle party Saturday night. This year's party had a great DJ and dancing continued well into the evening. The horse show itself was very competitive. One of the only glitches was the downpours Friday night that forced the moving of some classes to Saturday evening, especially the beautiful and popular Friesian costume class. All in all Octoberfest was a great show again this year and it continues to be a popular ending to a great New England show season.

Five-Gaited

The first gaited class of the week was the Junior Exhibitors. Naughty, with Alexis Pearson, and Platinum's What A Rush, with Marissa Gillispie, raced around the ring vying for the blue. In the qualifier it was Naughty with the winning go, but in the championship, Platinum's What A Rush and Marissa were the only ones coming back to take the tricolor. The open gaited horses were next with David Cater and Our Secret Weapon making two outstanding shows to win the blue and the championship ribbons for owner Narotam Singh Grewal. Reserve in both classes went to Collector Series ridden by Denise Vespa for Maureen Mokrzycki. The junior/novice class was won by an impressive two-year-old of Jan Lukens. Perfectly Designed put on quite a show to capture the blue over Gary Garone riding Across The

Sky for owner Delores Barker. The only entry in the Amateur class was Montgomery Burns and Sally Kropp riding for Kropp River Stables.

Three-Gaited

One of the finest divisions of the show was the three-gaited. In every class quality reigned. The first group of the week were open horses. Robin McGahey piloted Elaine Gregory's Coco Royale to the blue ribbon beating

out the impressive Sue Me and Annika Bruggeworth. Sue Me went on to take the red ribbon in the ladies class and to win the tricolor in the Amateur championship later in the week. The winner of the amateur qualifier, My California Girl, ridden by owner Sally Gallagher, was shown back to the win in the open championship by trainer Kristen Cater beating out Robin and Coco Royale by a nose. New England favorite Sightline, with owner Holli Esposito in the irons, took home the blue in the ladies class. The junior exhibitors put on such an impressive show that a championship class was added for them. Heir's Sparkling Star and Giovanna Leone put on a picture perfect performance in both the qualifier and the championship to sweep the division. A strong reserve in both classes went to Diamonds I am and Ashley Bradbury.

Fine Harness

The single fine harness horse was My Special Dream driven by Jon Douglas for owner Judith Heinbach.

Park

The L.M. Turner Stables showdown took place Saturday night in the A-1 Park Sweepstakes. There are four of these classes held throughout the year at four different New England shows. The class is open to three-year-olds and under. Rob Turner is always one to have a nice young horse to put in this division. This time he had two with the second entry being ridden by his assistant Jessica Verrill. The class was neck and neck until the last canter. With a flawless performance, Rob and Charmed By Charm took the win for owner Parker View Farm. Jessica was a very close second with Reggie's Indigo Jim for owner Holli Esposito. Two park favorites moved into the junior exhibitor ranks. Snorkle, ridden by Caroline Rose for owner Mary Beth Alosa, looked right at home to win both the qualifier and the championship. The red ribbon in the qualifier went to Fantasy's Castle and TJ Santaferria riding for Lori Neumann. After a bit of a struggle in her debut in the qualifier, Alexandra Percoco put on one of the most talked about performances of the show to take the reserve ribbon in the championship on her mother's CH Cagin Martini. In the junior /novice division, Hawkwing and Jan Lukens took home the blue for owner Margaret Biggs. Second place went to Roseridge Steven Kyng and Jessica Verrill riding for owners James

and Judith Motley. Hawkwing came back in the open championship to take the reserve. Winner of both the open qualifier and championship was the elegant Pearl Buck's Leading Lady with David Arnold in the irons for owner Gail Dearth. The red ribbon in the open qualifier went to Will Bailey and owner Elaine Gregory. A competitive amateur qualifier was won by Betty Reeves showing A Design To Remember for owner Lynn Carol Schweikert. Second in the qualifier went to the winner of the championship, Mystery Guest and owner Diane Tambussi. The reserve tricolor in the amateur championship went to Careen Dubuc riding He Is The Heir for Phoenix Prophecies, LLC.

Show Pleasure

Annika Bruggeworth debut her new South African horse Sultan's Zorba by winning the adult three-gaited show pleasure qualifier. This elegant entry put on a stunning performance to take the blue. The red ribbon was given to Charm's Top Cat with owner Sheana Kerwin in the irons. In the championship it was Charm's Top Cat moving up to take the tricolor. Reserve in the championship went to the winner of the novice rider class, Daddy-O, with Julie Barker riding for Delores Barker. The 14 and under junior exhibitors put on consistent performances going one, two, three in both classes. CH

Memories Of Memphis and Caroline Rose came out on top in both classes. Melina LaBonte piloted Corporate Focus to the second and reserve placing for owner Judy LaBonte. Third in both classes went to Elusive Love Affair and owner Kate Owen. The 15-17 year olds did the same thing, CH New York Entertainer swept the divi-

sion with owner Jessica MacLeod in the irons. Second and reserve went to Spirited Edition and Christie Milbury. Third in both classes was the grand campaigner CH Can't Touch This and Susan Adams.

Following in her mother's footsteps and continuing a long family tradition of showing Saddlebreds, was Mollie Codeanne. Riding Captain Planet, Mollie won both the walk and trot 8 and under pleasure qualifier and the combined walk and trot pleasure championship. Second in the 8 and under qualifier was Medomak Ever Beamin ridden by Lexie Lettre. In the 9 and 10-year-old walk and trot qualifier it was Alexa Bik showing Westenfeld Band Leader to the blue ribbon. The red ribbon was taken home by Stephanie Shoubash showing Classic Star. Classic Star and Stephanie also took home the reserve ribbon in the combined championship.

One of the largest five-gaited divisions of the show was the pleasure division. Six competitive entries vied for the blue. Lauren Sopel and Slam's Steel Magnolia racked away with the blue ribbon in the qualifier. In the championship they dropped back to reserve with CH Berry Garcia and owner/rider Caroline Ann DeShaies moving up for the win.

Show Pleasure Driving

A solid pleasure driving class was won by Unclaimed with owner Jan Beardsley-Blanco at the lines. They did not show back in the championship leaving the door wide open for Harlem's Beau Dandy driven by owner Kathleen Osnoe to move up for the championship win. Second and reserve went to Callback and Bob Funkhouser.

Park Pleasure

A large class of young horses, the junior park pleasure prospects, started off the week. Storming past all competitors was Rob Turner and Roseridge Get Ready to win the blue for owners Marcy Caton and Terry Collins. The red ribbon in the qualifier went to Twist And Twirl shown by Darlene Trento-Wright for Paul Moore. Rob and Roseridge Get Ready did not show back in the championship leaving the field wide open for CF A Rare Genius with David Cater in the irons for owner Catherine McCool to ride away with the tricolor. All Charmed Up with owner/rider Leslie Bovenzi moved up from third in the qualifier to take the reserve ribbon.

Country Pleasure

Putting in another nice ride was Holli Esposito showing Co-Ed's Impressive Lady to the victories in both the adult qualifier and championship for owner Mrs. Paul Rice. The red ribbon in the qualifier went to another Rob Turner trained entry Platinum Asset and owner Roberta Hirshon. Moving way up for the reserve championship was Stonewall's Night Of Pandemonium ridden by Mary Coon. Taking the blue in the novice rider class was Co-Star's Irish Blend shown by Edie Shipley for owners Jo Hight and Natalie Libby. Another Gregory Stables entry, Sports Bar, ridden by TJ Santaferra, took the blue ribbon in the junior exhibitor qualifier. The red ribbon was taken home by Jill Mojave and Cimarron's Firewater. They swapped places in the championship with Cimarron's Firewater moving up for the win and Sports Bar dropping back to reserve.

The western division was surprisingly light. The single entry in the western country pleasure qualifier was Maverick's Miracle Mike ridden by Ray Ann Merrill for owner Cynthia Merrill. There was also a single entry in the *Saddle & Bridle* Shatner Western Pleasure class. He's Baack and Marissa Gillispie jogged out with the blue for Wriighthall Stables. The two came together in the western country

pleasure championship, with Maverick's Miracle Mike coming out on top with He's Baack jogging up for the reserve.

A relatively new division in New England, the ASB Hunter Country pleasure division, was dominated by Specially Designed and Amanda Boutet sweeping both classes. Second and reserve went to Chumbawamba and Brianna Walsh riding for Paula Walsh.

Hackney Ponies

Sue Spann drove her Skymark with elegant precision to sweep the Hackney pony division. The red ribbon in the qualifier went to Mark Of Recognition and owner Frank Hester. Reserve in the championship was pinned on Hyde Locke Charles R driven by Nancy Locke for Catherine Locke.

Hackney/Harness Ponies

The elegant harness ponies had a good turnout. Ryan Fornango, driving for the Misty Hills Farm LLC, took Twin Willow's Dimitri to the top in the open qualifier and championship. Right before the winner was announced in the championship, a tribute to longtime New England Hackney exhibitor Frank Hester was read (see sidebar). When Ryan drove up to accept the championship, Frank was waiting in the wings to make the victory pass. Having just placed third in the road pony championship, Frank in his silks hopped in and drove Twin Willow's Dimitri out with the tricolor flying! High Mark and Darlene Trento Wright driving for owner Maureen Quackenbush, was second and reserve in both classes.

Hackney Pony Pleasure Driving

Campaigner Model Of Excellence pulled double duty at this show. Driven by owner Dawn DelTorchio he trotted away with the blue in the pleasure driving qualifier. He then went on to a reserve placing in the championship. In between those two classes Dawn let a novice driver take the reins. Nicole McLaine looked right at home driving Model Of Excellence to the blue in the novice driver class.

A tribute to longtime New England Hackney exhibitor

Frank Hester

Many people have called Frank Hester “a good man” and he truly is. Born in Mississippi in 1926, he grew up on a small family farm: with nine brothers and sisters. Frank is a World War II Navy Vet. After the war he migrated to the Northwest corner of Connecticut. He is the father of two girls; Betty Ann and Frances Jean.

One day in 1970, Frank first noticed Hackney ponies frolicking in a pasture in New Marlborough, Mass. That was the famous Cassilus Farm. It wasn't long before he bought a yearling from them called Whippoorwill Connie. He started his show ring career in the pleasure driving class at the old Farmington, Conn., show.

Through the years he has shown many Hackneys including ponies for Ken and Evelyn Harris from High and Mighty Stables. They showed in hand, harness and roadsters classes. The roadster classes are Frank's first love. He has a great time competing in them.

Frank and the great Standardbred horse First Nick were always a crowd favorite. They won the \$1,000 Roadster Horse Championship at the State Fair in Syracuse, N.Y., twice; and many other classes too numerous to mention. Frank would speak to Nicky and Nicky would give him a “I hear yah” tail flip and away they would go.

He also broke and trained several carriage Hackneys, one we called Sweetheart. Sweetheart and his owner Mary Kimmelman won the single pony championship and marathon at Devon, Penn., and the Walnut Hill invitational — not an easy task.

Frank's latest two ponies are the cob tail, Mark Of Recognition and the veteran road pony, multi champion, Dream Boy's Magic. Magic and Frank are like “two peas in a pod”. This true gentleman trainer and his pony sidekick, are the best of friends.

His other true love is Amy, his little Jack Russell. She goes wherever Frank goes. She rides in back of manure baskets, on carts, in Mack and pick-up trucks. Lord help Frank if he doesn't take her! We all know that she is the real boss!

Through the years Frank has been a director of the Northeast Hackney Association. He has been an exceptional helping hand to anyone who needed it.

We thank you Frank. You are a wonderful horseman, a friend and a mentor to all.

The red ribbon in the novice driver class went to Thomas Headwell showing Marked By Rhythm for his family's Misty Hills Farm LLC. Another longtime New England favorite Atta-Boy, driven by Donald Pasquariello for owner Kevin Gibbons, took the red ribbon home in the pleasure driving qualifier. He managed to put it all together in championship to defeat Model Of Excellence and take home the tricolor.

Friesians

Making perfect show after perfect show no matter the division or rider was Gooitzen Fan Teakesyl. Owned by Annika Bruggeworth he started out the week winning the six entry Friesian in hand class. Then Annika stepped into the irons to win the Friesian pleasure-junior/novice horse class. “Gootz” then went on to close out the week by winning the eight horse Friesian English pleasure championship over the winner of the qualifier, Jorritt. Jorritt, who placed reserve, was ridden by David Arnold for owners Lou and Delia Fox. David Arnold showed

another nice Friesian, Jort, to the blue and the tricolor in the Friesian walk-trot only division. Jort is owned by Brandon Marvelle. Second and reserve in the walk-trot division was Dowe with Amanda Bruno riding for Robert Loop. A beautiful class entered the ring for the rescheduled Friesian costume class. Cantering off with the win was Shelly Crawford who looked like a fairy princess riding Hidde Van de Kortmanshoeve. Earlier in the week Shelly, in more traditional attire, placed reserve with Hidde Van de Kortmanshoeve in the junior/novice class. Denise McCabe, riding Teake S, was second in the costume class.

There were only two entries in the Friesian pleasure driving class. In the qualifier it was Hindrick B driven by owner Cindy Flaherty driving out with the blue ribbon. The red ribbon went to Hattie driven by David Arnold for owner Rosemary Saccocia. In the championship the two traded places with Hattie coming out on top and Hindrick B settling for reserve.

Equitation

The irresistible lead line class was won by Kellie Saccocia riding Indian Creek Belle Star. Second went to Nicole Leone riding The Pinnacle.

Walk and trot equitation turned out to be a family affair for the McCool sisters. Winning both the 10 and under qualifier and combined championship was Margaret McCool riding Virtual Viper. The 10 and under UPHA Challenge Cup was won by sister Clara McCool riding CH Evening Dazzle. Winner of the 8 and under qualifier was Kasey Saccocia riding Indian Creek Belle Star. Kasey was also reserve in the combined championship. Placing second in both the 8 and under qualifier and the UPHA 10 and Under Challenge Cup and taking a third in the combined championship, was Holly Hacskeylo riding Whitehall's Carded Captain. Second in the 10 and under qualifier went to Nicole Percoco showing Solidarity's Sweet Georgia.

Winning the saddle seat equitation 17 and under qualifier and championship was Olivia Prentiss riding The Princess Dianna. Second and reserve in both classes was Michaela Gillispie riding Phoenix Suns Shine. Michaela also won NEHC Medal class with second going to Sarah Brow.

Danielle Jones, riding Another World, took home the blue in the pleasure equitation 14 and under qualifier. In the 15-17 year old age group it was Brittany Ford riding Phi's Jama Party to the win and Carly Cibelli coming in second on Snap, Crackle, & Pop. The victory in the combined championship went to Melissa Swain on Callaway's Meriwether, Melissa had also placed second in the 14 and under qualifier earlier in the week. Reserve in the championship went to Taryn Marshall riding Electric Circus.

Miscellaneous

First classes of the week were the in hand classes. It is nice to see a show that still offers this division. For the Saddlebreds it was Jan Lukens leading the stylish CH Cagin Martini to victory for owner Paula Percoco. Second in the class went to Corporate Focus led by trainer Robin McGahey for owner Judy LaBonte. In the pony in hand class it was another striking entry from Misty Hills Farm, Twin Willow's Triumphant being led to the blue by trainer Ryan Fornango. The red ribbon went to Moose Meadow Pre-Te Woman being led by owner Samantha Luce. Another division that you don't see too often is
