## Wednesday

Wednesday morning began with a large class of yearlings in the Indiana Futurity open class. Call Me Regal was the top baby by Call Me Ringo and out of New York's Crown Jewel. Joe T. Smith handled the duties for David Mountjoy. Reedann's Go For It was reserve for Doc Raun's Reedannland Farm. The three-gaited limit class was a nice one with Stealing The Show and Zach Duffy taking the blue home for Bel Cheval with Hero's Forever Ablaze and Mark Turner making the reserve grade for DeLovely Farm.

The country pleasure driving champion was named Shakespeare In Love and driven by Karen Thompson with Heir Express and Joan Todd in reserve. The two-year-old Indiana fine harness futurity had a nice compliment of entrants. None were judged to be better than Last Class driven by Bret Day for the Fischer Sisters. Last Class is by The Sky King and out of So Like. Reserve was Steel The Moment and Louis Blaze. A unanimous decision for Talladega Red was given in the junior three-gaited park class with Dena Lopez in the irons for Kay Marschel. Reserve went to Callaway's Cinnamon Bay and Smith Lilly for Lora Johnstone.

The amateur road pony champion was Heartland Carolee and Kevin Ingram for James Dellinger, with the reserve speeding away with Regal's Poetic Moment LF and Amber Estis. A unanimous victory was in hand for Sarah Russell in the country pleasure adult class as she rode out of the ring last atop Haunting. Coolside and Jessica Wilson were reserve.

A nice group of five-gaited limit entries were shown in the next class, this time Limebank's King Of Clubs put on the best display for the blue ribbon with Mark Turner up for Magdalena Meyer. (SA) Space Buccaneer and Melissa Moore were reserve for John Bulmer. Heartland Fortune Maker and Darrel Kolkman were the best of the class in the UPHA Hackney Classic. Regal's Top Gun and Mike Richardson were reserve for Dan Light.

Another full class was had in the three-gaited show pleasure qualifier, which saw the fine quality of CH Lightnin' Lil shining through for the win with Nicole Beltz Tolliver up. Reserve in this nice class was earned by CH My Grande and Amanda Dellinger. Bristle N and Katie Coup scored the win in the roadster limit class, with Red Heart and Don Heath reserve. The three-gaited park pleasure winner was Steal My Thunder and John Fields for Marty Reynolds, with

Wrapping up the day was a nice big class for weanling futurity entrants shown by an amateur. It also marked the first time that Winsdown Farm ever placed first in a class, after years of trying, at the All American Classic. None were more pleased at this turn of events than owner, Louise Gilliland, whose son, James Vantrease made Winsdown Classic Day outshine the rest for the big check and big ribbon. Winsdown Classic Day is out of Mountainview's Oh Heavenly Day and out of Lil Smith. Little did Ms. Gilliland know at the time but good things happen in threes. Reserve went to Wild Sky, shown by Mary Waickman.

Due to several classes with only one entry (not listed here but in the results) Wednesday evening's

performance went quickly and featured the show pleasure five-gaited class, with Debbie Owens taking home the blue aboard Callaway's Another Winner. Reserve went home with Mary Jane Fredrickson and her A Cloudburst. In the three-gaited ladies class, Melissa Moore won a nice trophy on her Worthy's Pure Love, while Elizabeth McLemore placed reserve for Hallston Manor with The Proof Is In The Heir.

It was a blue for Jane Mueller and her Supreme Platinum in the show pleasure driving class, followed by a nice reserve placement for Kathy Capsuto's Dancing Up A Storm.

Winning the harness pony amateur class was Nacho Mama and Christy Gantley, with Unique's Fine N Fancy in reserve. A large class, was nonetheless a unanimous choice for the three

judges, making the thrill of victory all the sweeter for trainer, Bret Day aboard the Woodsider for Hy Horse Farm. Reserve in this nice class was Ya Ya and Dena Lopez for Elizabeth Shatner.

Another unanimous award was at hand for Todd Miles atop Arrowhead's Dreamcatcher for Deborah Butler in the five-gaited junior class. Flight Night and Louis Louw were reserve for David Nierenberg. Jane Mueller had her second victory of the day behind Early Edition in the open Hackney pleasure driving class. Hawkeye's Seven Eleven and Faydelle Schott were reserve.

The three-gaited park amateur class was won by French Kiss and Emily Abbott in a nice display of fashion, with Caramac's Counterclaim and Susan Hall winning the reserve ribbon. A unanimous win was awarded to Brookhill's Tom Tom in a large class of park pleasure junior three-gaited entries. Steve Demjen was in the irons for owner Danielle Loar. Reserve honors were given to Renee Biggins and South Street, up for Linda and Homer Beltz.

The amateur Hackney class featured Kilbro's Code Red and Catherine Houck for the trophy, while Wait & See's Reality and Steve Golden took reserve honors home. From the small to the tall, next in were the Friesian pleasure walk and trot entries, which placed Emily Abbott and Hylke in first and Mindy Van Hellemont and Loek B in reserve.

The UPHA Hackney roadster pony classic placed Doc Raun and Velvet King in first with Heartland Curtain Call taking reserve honors for Darrel Kolkman. Wrapping up the evening's classes was the five-gaited ladies class which had Dena Lopez taking the blue home for Belle Reve Farm and The Kentucky Saddler and Elizabeth McLemore racking off with the red ribbon. After the show, the exhibitors and spectators alike were invited to an appetizer party sponsored by Frickey Farms.

#### Thursday

Ever wonder how many weanlings the Pepsi Coleseum can hold, end to end? 35 seems to be about right with 35 weanlings competing in the Indiana open weanling futurity. Louise Gilliland was still floating on cloud 9 from her prized weanling's win on the prior day, nearly blew my eardrum out when Winsdown Classic Day bested them all again. Her son James Vantrease certainly earned his keep with his superb handling skills, worthy at least of a nice steak dinner, as I suggested! Reserve went to Wing May's Irish Charm and Buddy Waggoner. Charm is by Irish Mystic and out of Hanku's High Falutin'. This was an amazing class full of outstanding Saddlebreds, giving those in attendance renewed hope that the Saddlebred industry can continue to produce a high volume of top notch prospects like those on display this day.

The two-year-old futurity amateur class was, though not as big, still full of quality entrants, this time He's Kinda Special proved name worthy, by My Kinda' Lovin' and out of Gotta Love It, George

The three-gaited junior class was taken by crowd favorite Punch Baby and Jackie Tanner for Joe and Sarah Benza. Reserve was Callaway's Compatible and Smith Lilly for Lora Johnstone.

A big class of novice three-gaited entrants was next up, and besting the rest was Top Gun's Mandate and Gloria Heath for Euro Motorworks. Reserve to this nice team was Beaujolais Nouveau and Toria Heck for Liz and Randy Thomas. Keeping with the French-named theme was Voulez Vous and Tiffany Wheeler as they trotted away with the fine harness UPHA Classic trophy in grand style for Chris Nalley and mother, Jean. Bucardi and Steve Demjen were reserve for Kelly Naylor.

Another loaded class with country western talent, this time of the limited variety, entered next, and it was the beginning of a fine week for Yellow Rose Starafar and Susann Strayer as they marched out the winners with Intellectual High and Jill Wilson in reserve. The limit road pony class was up next for a dramatic change of pace, and it was To B Or Not To B and Ed Murray racing out of the ring last for owner Luc Boileau. Reserve in this nifty class was Hey Dude and Matthew Schuckert for David Estes.

The UPHA three-gaited park pleasure class was another fine display of the gorgeous Saddlebred aplenty with Cape Grace and Smith Lilly taking home the blue for Stephanie McMahon. Reserve went to Brookhill's Kool As Ice and Jackie Tanner for the O'Brien family. The beautiful black Arrowhead's Captain Morgan and Kristie Keating trotted out with the blue and silver in the the country pleasure novice class, with Jon Michael Heir and Diana Schrader taking the red silk home.

The UPHA five-gaited cup will reside in Versailles after the nice show put on by Billy Jarrell aboard his Callaway's Carnival In Rio, while Masette and Mike Roberts bested the rest for reserve position for Karen Coup. The limit Hackney pleasure driving pony champion was Knolland Liberty Belle and Nicole Reason, with Late Nite's Party Flight and Karen Wood taking home the reserve.

Wrapping up the afternoon with her third win in two days was the aforementioned Louise Gilliland, this time with a big win for her grey Winsdown

Thursday night began with a class full of tiny Hackney pony weanlings in the Breeder's Stake, enticing the crowd with their cute charms, and the judges with their conformation. Taking home about \$8,000 was Extremely Supreme Star for Jim Spurrier. This mighty weanling is sired by The Extremist and out of Truly A Impressive Star. Reserve in the class went to Fritz's Hot Date and Jay Kennedy for Jay Fitzpatrick. Another full class happened next in the always popular country pleasure Western division. Besting 12 other entries was the popular big bay, Yellow Rose Star and owner/rider Susann Strayer. Reserve went to Michele Macfarlane and her renowned CH Like

Thunder.

The ladies road pony class went to Biggy Smalls, driven to the winner's circle by owner Mindy Van Hellemont. Reserve was the property of Wonmore's Just Let's Dance and Debbie McKeown. Afterwards, during a break in the action, Karen Frickey and the late Ed Frickey were inducted into the All American Hall of Fame for all their contributions and efforts as owners of Frickey Farm.

Next up was a knock-out class of fine harness two-year-old entrants, competing for some of the significant prize money offered that evening in the Sweepstakes program. First in this class was Last Class, ridden by Bret Day for the Fischer Sisters. Last Class is by The Sky King and out of So Like, and earned a cool \$3,300 for the sisters. Reserve, but still taking home \$2,500, was Kidwick Hall and Darrell Case for Tri Color Ventures. No strangers to winning were the victors of the open Hackney class, Marilyn Macfarlane and her Fancy Ribbons. Kenhurst Kalahari and Pat Kennedy were reserve.

The amateur three-gaited class was well-rounded and featured Karen Mayer this time in the stirrups atop Simbara's Cara Mia, again for the Fischer Sisters. Reserve went to It's Z Prince and Carla Ritzie for Carl Holden. More sweepstakes money was to be had in the five-gaited two-year-old class, which had Attache's Easter Present and Dianna Rannells in the winner's circle, with a nice reserve check going home with MBA's The Powers That Be, with Pat McConnell up for MBA.

Mary Gaylord McClean was in fine form at the lines of her Mastercraft's Promoter LF in the UPHA harness pony classic, and took home the blue ribbon for her efforts. Heartland Exclamation and Darrel Kolkman were reserve. Racing around the

Pepsi Coleseum for their amateur roadster blue were Thomas Fielder and his Valparaiso, while Don Heath was racing back to the barns with his red ribbon behind his entry, Red Heart.

More of that lush Sweepstakes money was up for grabs in the two-year-old park pleasure class, this time it was First Class Day's turn to graze on the green, with Gerhardt Roos taking the cash home for Tillman Stables. Reserve went to Ravishing Man and Tom Pettry for Reedannland. Reserve went to the pretty Crystal Creek's Royal Prince shown by Eduardo Lopez. It was three for three for Darrel Kolkman as he presented the elegant Heartland Cover Girl to the Hoosier Hackney Futurity Two-Year-Old Filly win. Jim Spurrier and the brilliant Extremely A Dream scored second.

Lighting up the ring with beauty and brilliance with every pass, was the splendid pair of Tara Duff and Valhallelujah to take the country pleasure AOT blue. Jessica Sorenson guided her thrilling Time To Thrill to reserve. Matthew Taylor presented the marvelous Michigan's Artistic Impression to victory in the Hoosier Hackney Futurity Two-Year-Old Colt and Gelding class. The red ribbon went

home with the sparkling Extremely A Dark Star and Jim Spurrier.

The afternoon session started at noon with the exciting two-year-old fine harness class. Victory belonged to the outstanding performer The Norseman and Dr. Alan Raun. Mike Roberts presented the bold and brilliant Back On Top to reserve. Winning the Hoosier Hackney Futurity Four- and Five-Year-Old was the lovely Made You Look with Laurie Palmer on the lines. The radiant Regal's Top Gun and Jeff Vogel were reserve.

Twelve outstanding show stars returned for the adult three-gaited show pleasure championship with an absolutely spectacular performance by the awesome world champion pair of CH Lightnin' Lil and Nicole Beltz Tolliver to win it all. Reserve honors went home with the marvelous match of My Southern Charm and Brooke Jacobs. Speeding in winning style was the exciting Mr. Lucky Man and Maureen Lydon to win the Hoosier Hackney Futurity Four- and Five-Year-Old Roadster class. Joe Jenkins guided Work In Progress to reserve.

Commanding top honors in the country pleasure driving championship was the lovely Shakespeare In Love and Karen Thompson. Reserve went to the glowing star Heir Express and Joan Todd. Displaying poise and polished style was the classic young beauty Christina Collis to win the saddle seat equitation 13 and under blue.

The breathtaking team of Jackie Tanner and The Woodsider were crowned the three-gaited park grand champions. Dena Lopez guided the sensational Ya Ya to the reserve tricolor. Possessing perfect form and classic beauty, Morgan Wolin garnered the adult saddle seat equitation victory. The classic beauty Brooke Jacobs was reserve. The high-fashioned Boxford Perfect Timing won the Hoosier Hackney Futurity Four- and Five-Year-old Harness blue with Pat Kennedy driving. Steve Smith drove the motioned Bristolwood Charismatic to reserve.

Nine exciting three-gaited park pleasure con-

tenders returned to their championship, and the winning number belonged to the crowd-pleasing combination of Darrell Case and the spectacular Riders On The Storm. Reserve went to the thrilling and colorful celebrity Steal My Thunder and John Field. Displaying equitation at its best was the talented Jourdan Schaye and she captured the pleasure equitation 14-17 blue. The gifted and pretty Sarah Lawson was reserve. Showing speed at every pass, Regal's One More Promise LF and Ed Murray earned the Hackney roadster to wagon blue.

Debbie Owens and her awesome Callaway's Another Winner were crowned the five-gaited show pleasure grand champions after a brilliant show. Linda Beltz presented her illustrious Champagne's Irish Sea to reserve. The pleasure equitation 13 and under blue was won by the talented and pretty Allison Shuh. Reserve honors went to the classic young beauty Allison Harpole. A winning starlet indeed was Crystal Creek Starlet, expertly shown by Kathryn Nichols to win the Hoosier Hackney Futurity Four- and Five-Year-Old Pleasure Driving blue. Top honors in the Hoosier Hackney Futurity Weanling Colt class was captured by the radiant Heartland Right On Time presented by Darrel Kolkman. The reserve honor went home with the outstanding Sky Lord presented by Jerry Elmer.

Possessing a winning look and style, Kristen Pettry and Callaway's Scoop The News took the country pleasure hunter championship victory. Beth Oliver and her celebrated Kansas City were reserve. With great talent and a truly splendid style, Cyndi Simmons garnered the UPHA Five-Gaited Horsemanship blue.

Creating much excitement for victory in the Hoosier Hackney Futurity Three-Year-Old Hackney Pony class was the astonishing Regal's Lucifer piloted perfectly by Jeff McClean for the win. Jim Spurrier drove the exciting Irresistible to reserve.
