Highlighting a grand week at the 2007 World's Championship Horse Show in Louisville, Ky., was the dual wins posted by Miss Sarah Werry, daughter of Glenn A. Werry and Beth Werry. She piloted the handsome Catalyst son, He Walks On Water, to the unanimous Juvenile Country Pleasure title in division A of the 14-17 age bracket, before returning for the 14-17 Juvenile Country Pleasure World's Champion of Champions tricolor and floral blanket.

Glenmore Farm also had success in the Amateur Roadster to Bike class when Glenn T. Werry, Sarah's brother and a sophomore in college, presented the athletic Gingerbread Man to the top spot in division A of that event. In a repeat of 2006, Heir To A Star, by Supreme Heir and out of the grand show mare CH Super Serenade, and Glenn T. Werry were named the 2007 Amateur Gentlemen's Three-Gaited World's Champions.

Glenn's wife, Michelle Werry, was elated with the performances turned in by her daughters Faye Wuesthofen, riding Callaway's Lil Abner to a third place finish in the Juvenile 14-17 Five-Gaited class, and Jessica Wuesthofen, riding Amelia Heir Cat, who is by Supreme Heir, to the Reserve World's Championship title in the Three-Gaited Pony 13 and Under division.

He Walks On Water, Heir To A Star, Gingerbread Man and Callaway's Lil Abner are under the direction of Glenmore Farms' resident trainer, Tom Bombolis. Amelia Heir Cat is under the direction of LaFleur Van Ess Stables.
