The Illinois State Fairgrounds has the best indoor facility in the country, with great stabling and permanent footing. How many other indoor horse arenas have permanent footing and only have equine competitions in the ring? Not too many. The hospitality of the people is also a lovely plus. With many barns from throughout the Midwest and Southeast competing, it is surely a competitive show. However, the numbers have declined over the years. There is plenty of stabling and some of the best horses and ponies in the country. The one drawback is a severe lack of parking, but exhibitors have been contacting the State Fair Board in order to get that situation

remedied. This is a fun and competitive show at a truly world class facility, and everyone should mark it on their calendar for next year.

This year the heat was inescapable, and hats and coats were optional throughout the week. However, the heat did not deter any entries, and people were still showing full tilt despite the oppressive humidity. You can never predict the weather in Springfield in August; I have been there years it has been so cold that people were running out to buy sweatshirts. The fans operating in the coliseum made the heat more bearable for spectators, but center ring was boiling as always. Lots of water and

Five-Gaited

The sharp moving chestnut Sheba's Charm reigned supreme in the very competitive Five-Gaited Stake, piloted by the skilled Jim Lowry. He had this horse squared up and tucked together as they trotted and racked their way to victory. The awesome Starlet's Commendable and Armon Effinger rode hard for the reserve tricolor. Earlier in the week, the positions were reversed with Starlet's Commendable winning the Open qualifier and Sheba's Charm finishing in reserve.
