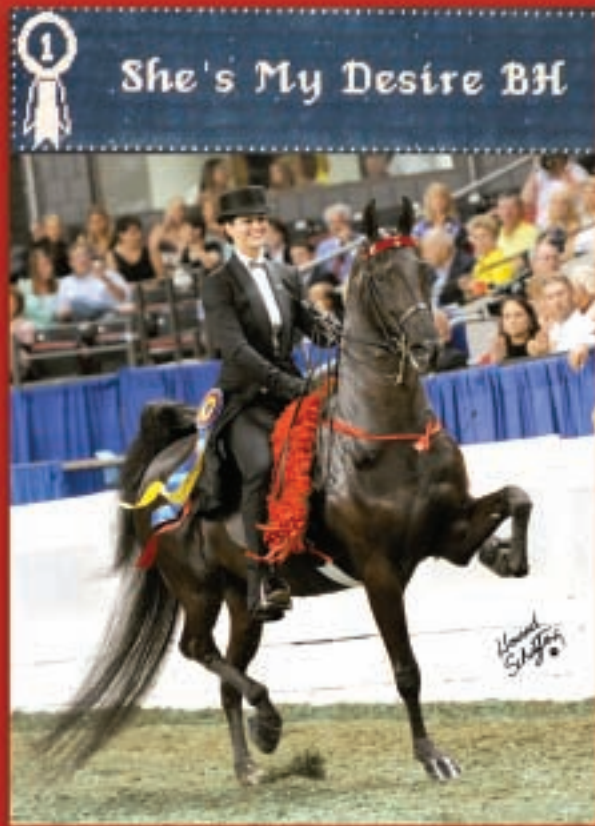

WC CH **She's My Desire**
and Sarah Werry

Gracing our September front cover is the newly paired and elegant duo of Sarah Werry and her 2008 World's Champion Juvenile Three-Gaited Mare, CH She's My Desire BH.

Sarah is the daughter of Glenmore Farm owner Glenn A. Werry and Beth Koller. Sarah was pictured on the front cover a year ago with her much-loved 2007 Juvenile Country Pleasure World's Champion CH He Walks On Water, who the family lost earlier this season.

The eight-year-old She's My Desire BH was acquired in early June 2008, when she was purchased from Bill and Nancy Becker's Shadow Run Farm. WC CH Harlem Town, a black three-gaited show stallion, who was successfully campaigned by David Rudder under the direction of Kalarama Farm, sired the mare. Her dam, CH It's A Beautiful Day, was also campaigned by Rudder for former owner Judy Shepherd in the highly competitive show pleasure division. Since both parents are black, the chances that they would produce a black offspring were fairly high, and She's My Desire BH is jet black and very feminine in her way of going.

Ironically, CH It's A Beautiful Day also produced the 2008 World's Champion Park Horse, Brookhill's Periday as well as CH Brookhill's King Of Kool, who is a full brother to She's My Desire BH. King Of Kool is also owned by Glenmore Farm and was shown by Jessica Wuesthofen to a Reserve World's Champion title in the Juvenile Show Pleasure 13 and Under division.

She's My Desire BH, whose barn name is "Bella," started her 2008 campaign with Sarah Werry at the Midwest Charity Horse Show in Springfield, Ill., where they won their first time in the ring together under the direction of Glenmore Farm trainer Tom Bombolis. From there they had one class at the ASAW Summerfun Show in Milwaukee, Wisc., before turning their sights to the 2008 World's Championship Horse Show. Amid a competitive field, they were victorious in the qualifier, but it was thought that Sarah was going to have to leave the show to return home to Peoria, Ill., where she had school activities awaiting her. But with the opportunity to show her beautiful mare back in the championship and go for the roses, was just too tempting and that is exactly what this lovely new pair did!
